

On The Way

Figures of Advent: Joseph's eloquent silence

The quietest of the Advent figures is Saint Joseph, the husband of Mary and father of our Lord. The Gospels record not one word of his. He is the original strong, silent type. But his silence is not empty or mute. It speaks volumes and instructs us how to approach the birth of Christ.

First, his silence teaches us contemplation. His is a prayerful, reflective silence. In his heart and mind he considers what is happening before him: our Lady's pregnancy, the appearance of the angel, the journey to Bethlehem, the birth of our Lord, the flight into Egypt, and so on. Although extraordinary, these events are nonetheless quiet, hidden, and obscure to the rest of the world. They require quiet and silence to receive and interiorize their meaning.

This is why our culture fails to grasp Christmas as anything more than an occasion for spending, gifts, and vacation. The quiet mysteries of Bethlehem are impenetrable to the loud and noisy. Hearing requires silence. Hearing the profound truths of our Lord's nativity requires a deeper silence. The meaning of our Lord's hidden conception and birth can only be opened by those who are willing to be still, silent, and reflective. By his silence, Saint Joseph shows us how to do this. He allows the truth to reveal itself to him.

By the way, this provides a hint as to why it can be difficult to get to know Joseph. Because he is a man of such silence and contemplation, only those who strive for those qualities can come to know him.

Second, his silence speaks of trust. One of the greatest signs of trust in another person is the capacity to be silent with him or her. At some point in relationships, words are neither sufficient nor necessary. Joseph's silence comes from his trust in Mary first of all. In their relationship, few words are necessary.

More importantly, Joseph trusts in God. None of what unfolds – the virginal conception, the homelessness in Bethlehem, the threat of Herod, the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt – is what he expected or planned. Yet he does not cry out, lament, or complain. Although he might not understand it, he trusts that God has a plan – and that that plan is for his good.

Finally, Joseph's silence speaks of work. Today we would perhaps say that work is his "love language." He demonstrates his love for Mary and Jesus not by words but by his labors for them. This is all the more important when we consider how often his efforts were frustrated. "There was no place for them in the inn" (Lk 2:7). So, Joseph had to find the cave for shelter. We should imagine him at work – finding that space, sweeping it out, and putting things in order so that it would be a fit place for our Lord's birth.

Of course, this is really a matter of *coworking* with God. Joseph is the simply the minister of the Incarnation. He is the "Shadow of the Father," the silent and trusting coworker, "who helped to carry out the great mysteries of our salvation (Post Communion prayer, Votive Mass of Saint Joseph).



Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

As you know, since the beginning of the pandemic we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross *farthest* from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross. The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.

Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.
