

On The Way

Figures of Advent: Mary's obedience

The most central figure in Advent is the Blessed Virgin Mary. We spend four weeks anticipating her giving birth. Her unique status as the Mother of God means that we learn from her how to prepare for Christ's birth and how to become His disciples. She is the first to show and perfectly embodies the "obedience of faith."

This obedience is nicely summarized in the ancient saying that Mary "first conceived Jesus in her heart before she conceived him in her womb." That is, her obedience brings about an interior, spiritual conception within her before the physical conception of Jesus.

In Hebrew the word for "hear" and "obey" is the same: shama. The biblical understanding is that to hear God necessarily means to respond to Him. Obedience is thus a matter of both receiving and responding to the will of God.

Mary first receives the Word of God perfectly. We often lack a receptivity to God's will because we (rightly) sense that it requires the end of our self-centered existence. We are not receptive because we do not trust that His will for us is better than we could will for ourselves. Because of our fallen human nature, we remain suspicious that God's will is somehow contrary to our good. We have a spiritually contraceptive attitude; we don't allow Him to be conceived within our hearts.

Because she was immaculately conceived and thus untouched by sin, Mary is perfectly receptive to God's will. She has no selfishness, no self-focus to make her suspicious of Him and is thus open to whatever He speaks. Mary is a pure vessel, capable of receiving God entirely and without reservation.

Even Mary's question to the angel – *How shall this be*, since I have no husband? – is rooted in faith. It presumes acceptance of God's will and seeks only to understand it further. Her final words to the angel of course capture her perfect receptivity: Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word.

But Mary's receptivity is not passivity. She responds perfectly to God's initiative. The angel Gabriel mentioned Elizabeth as an authoritative sign of God's work: "behold, your kinswoman Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son" (Lk 1:36). So, Mary sets out immediately - "with haste," or "promptly" - to visit her cousin and behold the sign.

The obedience of faith requires the appropriate response to God's will. If our refusal to receive God's will is spiritually contraceptive, the refusal to act on his will is abortive; it does not allow what our hearts have conceived to come to full life. How often we form good resolutions in our hearts but do not allow them to take flesh in our lives. We encounter the beauty of God's will and receive it with joy, but then fail to respond in a way that will bear fruit.

Of course, Mary is more than an example. She is our greatest intercessor. God established this relationship by coming to us through her. Through her He gives us the perfect example of discipleship. And through her He receives our prayers to become obedient: to receive and respond faithfully to Him.

Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

As you know, since the beginning of the pandemic we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross *farthest* from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross. The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.

Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.






