On The Way

The Mass in Slowest Motion: the Gloria

Immediately after the penitential rite follows the *Gloria* (as with so many prayers, the hymn's name comes from its first word in Latin). This hymn is sung or said on feasts, solemnities, and Sundays outside of Advent and Lent. The first words of the hymn – *Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will* – come from the angels' song on Christmas (Lk 2:8-14). The rest of it is the Church's composition, inspired by the hymn of the angels. The *Gloria* dates back to the fourth century. It later became part of Christmas Midnight Mass, when the bishop alone would sing it. From there it came into more general use.

The connection with Christmas is important. Angels sang the first *Gloria* to announce the coming of the Redeemer into a sinful world. In the Mass, we in effect revisit that first Christmas. After the Penitential Rite – that is, after acknowledging our sins – we sing the *Gloria* to announce all over again that God's grace and truth have penetrated a sinful world. This progression from repentance to joy is fitting and necessary. Only when we first acknowledge our sinfulness can we then sing of God's redemption.

The *Gloria* is a rich instruction in our faith and merits some reflection.

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. This familiar phrase carries a great deal of meaning. If we give glory to God Who is in the highest – if we seek to glorify Him in our worship and actions – then we will realize peace. What brings peace to every human heart is this right relationship with God. Which leads to a common question about the verse: *Why peace only to people of good will? Why not to everyone?* Of course, God desires everyone to know His peace. But not everyone seeks it. We try to find peace by giving glory – by giving our time, energy, and devotion – to the wrong things. We think peace will come to us on our terms and under our control. But only when we seek to give *Him* glory will our hearts realize their purpose and thus be at peace.

We can understand this truth also by way of a famous quote from the 2nd century martyr, Saint Irenaeus: *The glory of God is the living man; the life of man is the vision of God.* God has shown His power and might in various ways: fire from heaven, floods, lightning, etc. But His true glory is found in the human person – in each of us, the summit of His creation. When we live according to what He has created us to be, then His glory is here on earth. But the life that glorifies God cannot be drawn from a worldly source, no matter how hard we try. Rather, *the life of man is the vision of God.* It is our union with and constant contemplation of Him that gives us life and, in turn, gives Him glory.

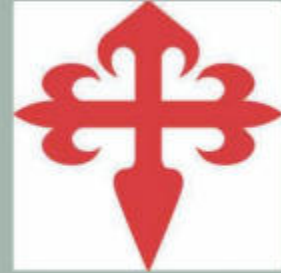
