

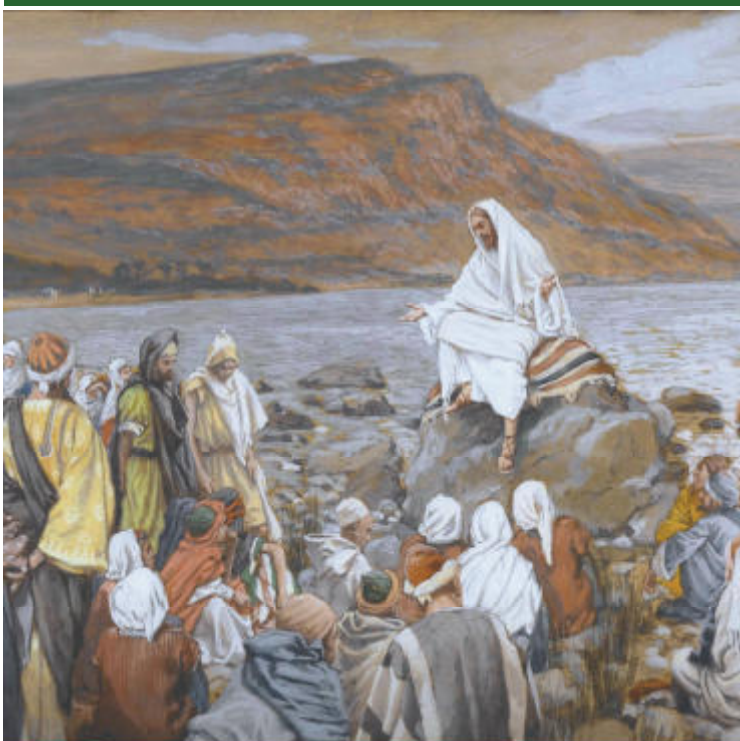

On The Way

The Gloria, II

The *Gloria* is divided into four distinct sections: the Christmas proclamation of the angels (which we looked at last week); praise of the Father; praise and invocation of the Son; and a final doxology *with the Holy Spirit*. The *Gloria* is thus a profoundly Trinitarian prayer, a hymn in praise of the Triune God.

The Father. After the introductory verse, the *Gloria* has a series of acclamations directed to the *Lord God, heavenly King, O God almighty Father*. The rapid listing of these verbs gives the sense of a childlike, energetic search for the proper words: *We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory...* Each one has its own shade of meaning, but they all share a common worship of the Father not for anything He has done (or will do) but simply because He *deserves* to be praised, blessed, adored, and glorified. Even in the last phrase, we give thanks, not for what He has done or will do, but simply for His great glory.

Here, then, at the beginning of the *Gloria*, we give voice to the highest form of prayer: adoration. Other forms of prayer – thanksgiving, contrition, petition – appeal to God for either what He has done or what we want/need Him to do. Here we worship God, not for any benefit that has or might come to us but simply because He is God and thus deserving of our worship.

The Son. Having praised the Father, the *Gloria* then acclaims and petitions the Son. This section begins with a simple invocation: *Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father*. Each of these titles is worthy of long meditation: Lord...Christ...Only Begotten Son...Lamb of God...and, of course, the Holy Name of Jesus.

Having acclaimed Jesus, we then appeal to Him: *you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us*. This threefold petition for mercy echoes the *Kyrie* that we sang or said earlier. It also calls our attention to the liturgical custom of doing or saying things in triplicate. Why do we do that?

First, for some reason, we humans have a need to repeat important things three times. We say *Happy birthday to you...Hip hip hooray!...For he's a jolly good fellow...*not once but three times each. The Hebrew language comes in to play here as well. Since Hebrew has no one word to express the superlative, it compensates by repeating the adjective three times. Instead of saying *Holiest*, for example, you say, *Holy, Holy, Holy*. Of course, since God is triune, there is something sacred, whole, and entire about sets of three.

The Spirit. The *Gloria* ends with a doxology (containing, as it happens, another triplet: *you alone are the Holy One...the Lord...the Most High...*) praising Christ *with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father*.

Ash Wednesday Mass Schedule—February 26

While Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation, it is still an important day in the Church calendar as it marks the start of Lent and our season of sacrifice and spiritual preparation to joyously celebrate the Resurrection of Christ. This year, Masses will be celebrated, and ashes distributed, on Wednesday, February 26, at 6:30am, 8:30am, Noon, and 7:30pm. Please make a concerted effort to attend one of these Masses to prepare yourself for the forty-days ahead.

Lenten Fasting Requirements

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For Roman Catholics, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Roman Catholics from age 14 onwards.
