## **On The Way**

### *Eucharistic Prayer I, the Roman Canon*

As mentioned last week, there are a variety of Eucharistic Prayers but only three that priests commonly use. The first Eucharistic Prayer is perhaps most well known as the longest of those three. But there is more to it than that!

Eucharistic Prayer I is also known as the "Roman Canon." It is "Roman" because it comes from the form of the Mass that developed in Rome (i.e. the Roman Rite). It is the "canon" because it was the fixed and unchanging part of the Mass (there were no other Eucharistic Prayers to choose from). In its current form the Canon dates back at least 1,000 years. Certain parts of the prayer date back much further, to the earliest years of the Church in Rome.

Some have criticized the Roman Canon for its lack of clear structure and progression. But such elements actually recommend it. They show that prayer is the product not of a committee but of organic devotion over the centuries. If it seems somewhat jumbled and disconnected at times, well seems like authentic prayer!

The Roman Canon is divided up into different parts, five before and five after the Consecration. The first part is a simple description of the parties involved in this prayer: *To you, therefore, most merciful Father, we make humble prayer and petition through Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord...* This is a nice summary of the entire Mass – our prayer to the Father through Jesus Christ.

Then the priest states before God our purpose: *that you accept and bless + these gifts, these offerings, these holy and unblemished sacrifices.* Notice the sacrificial tone of these words. We have come before the Father not primarily to get something but to offer something, indeed, the Sacrifice of His own Son. As he speaks these words the priest makes the sign of the Cross over the bread and wine, indicating that they are destined to become the holy and unblemished sacrifice of Christ Himself.

Then the prayer mentions the first beneficiary of this Sacrifice: the Church. The primary purpose of the Sacrifice and of Communion is to build up the Church, the Body of Christ. Thus the priest speaks of the sacrifice... *which we offer you firstly for your holy catholic Church. Be pleased to grant her peace, to guard, unite and govern her throughout the whole world, together with your servant Francis our Pope and Michael our Bishop, and all those who, holding to the truth, hand on the catholic and apostolic faith.*

Perhaps this sounds selfish. Perhaps our first concern should be the needs of our troubled world. But the Church can be of assistance to the world only to the degree that she is conformed to Christ's Sacrifice and built up by His Body. So, it is fitting that we petition the Father first of all for the Church, for without the Church's presence and witness nothing else can be accomplished.
