On The Way

The Mass in Slowest Motion: the Liturgy of the Word

The Liturgy of the Word comprises the first half of the Mass – from the first reading through the Universal Prayer (or Prayer of the Faithful). The earliest account of the Mass (from St. Justin Martyr, c. 155) describes it as follows:

The memoirs of the apostles and the writings of the prophets are read, as much as time permits. When the reader has finished, he who presides over those gathered admonishes and challenges them to imitate these beautiful things. Then we all rise together and offer prayers for ourselves...and for all others, wherever they may be, so that we may be found righteous by our life and actions, and faithful to the commandments, so as to obtain eternal salvation.

Every liturgy (Baptism, Confirmation, the Holy Eucharist, etc.) has the same basic structure: Word and Sacrament. First, the reading of scripture, then the celebration of the sacrament. We find this structure in our Lord's public life: first, He taught, and then He consummated His teaching by His crucifixion, the source of all sacramental grace.

We also find this structure in our Lord's appearance on the road to Emmaus (Lk 24:13-35) and Philip's encounter with the Ethiopian eunuch (Acts 8:26-40). In each case, there is first the proclamation of God's Word: *beginning with Moses and all the prophets, [Jesus] interpreted to them what referred to him in all the scriptures... Then Philip opened his mouth and, beginning with this scripture passage, he proclaimed Jesus to him.* Then the Sacrament: *while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them... Philip and the eunuch both went down into the water, and he baptized him.*

These examples reveal the purpose of the Liturgy of the Word: it prepares us to receive the grace of the sacrament it precedes. The attentive listening to the Word of God disposes us to receive precisely what He desires to give.

The Liturgy of the Word also reflects a fundamental characteristic in our relationship with God: the divine initiative and the human response. He always takes the initiative; we respond in faith. Each reading proclaims His truth. Our seemingly perfunctory responses – *Thanks be to God... Praise to You, Lord Jesus Christ* – actually express our faithful acceptance. The responsorial Psalm is a response to what we have heard (notice that it corresponds to the reading it follows). The homily once more proclaims God's truth (we hope), to which we again respond with a profession of faith (the Creed) and prayers of faith (the intercessions).

Finally, one other element should characterize the Liturgy of the Word: silence. The liturgical instructions say, *The Liturgy of the Word is to be celebrated in such a way as to favor meditation, and so any kind of haste such as hinders recollection is clearly to be avoided.* Indeed, for us to receive the Word of God and allow it to break up the soil of our souls, we need a degree of silence and an atmosphere of recollection.

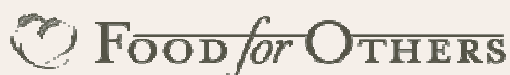
St. James Social Outreach Focus on Hunger—St. James Food Distribution
