On The Way

Catholic Social Doctrine: Property

We all know the 7th Commandment: *You shall not steal*. Now, that commandment rests on a fundamental principle: the right to private property. The only reason you cannot take your neighbors things is because he owns them fair and square.

At the same time, we know that ownership is not always fair and square. People can insist on their right to property without any regard for the genuine needs of others. And that would be not a use but an abuse of the right.

Once again we encounter the principle that every right exists within a broader framework and for the purpose of a fulfilling a responsibility. The right to property does not exist for its own sake. (In fact, the *only* right that exists for its own sake is the right to life – an important consideration during Respect Life Month and a reminder of the fundamental character of that issue.) It exists so that we can fulfill our responsibilities, both personal and social.

First, our personal responsibilities. We have a responsibility to care for ourselves (that's part of the 5th Commandment) and for those entrusted to us (that's included in the 4th Commandment). We therefore have a corresponding right to possess (by work or inheritance) those things necessary for the duty.

Thus, the state has a grave and fundamental obligation to protect the private property of its citizens. And the failure to do so (as we've seen in recent months) hurts the poor disproportionately. The wealthy can more easily protect and/or recover their property. The poor rely on the state to protect their right to what little they have.

Second, our social responsibilities. In addressing the 7th Commandment, the *Catechism*, discusses first the universal destination of goods: "In the beginning God entrusted the earth and its resources to the common stewardship of mankind to take care of them, master them by labor, and enjoy their fruits. The goods of creation are destined for the whole human race" (CCC 2402).

This overarching truth that God has created the goods of the earth for all peoples, not for one group or another, provides the framework and purpose for understanding the private ownership of goods. God grants us a real ownership of the goods of creation, *so that* we can use them to benefit all. He does not want us to be passive recipients or observers of his goodness. He wants us to *participate* in his goodness, to be stewards and ministers of the goods of creation by way of our own free will.

Nor does God want the benefits of creation to extend to others by way of faceless, impersonal, bureaucratic agencies. He desires that persons assist persons freely and lovingly. *For I was hungry and you gave me food...* So that we can fulfill that obligation, he grants us real ownership of property.

This is also the proper context in which to consider our obligation to care for the environment. It is not that animals or the earth have rights (only rational creatures have rights). It is, rather, that we have a duty to care for the earth, to keep it in good condition, since it has been entrusted to us for the good of all.

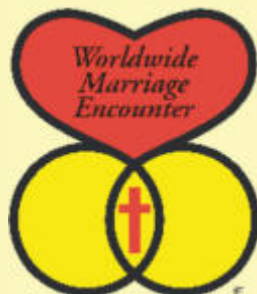
Annual Mass of Remembrance—Monday, November 2

Blessing of Pets

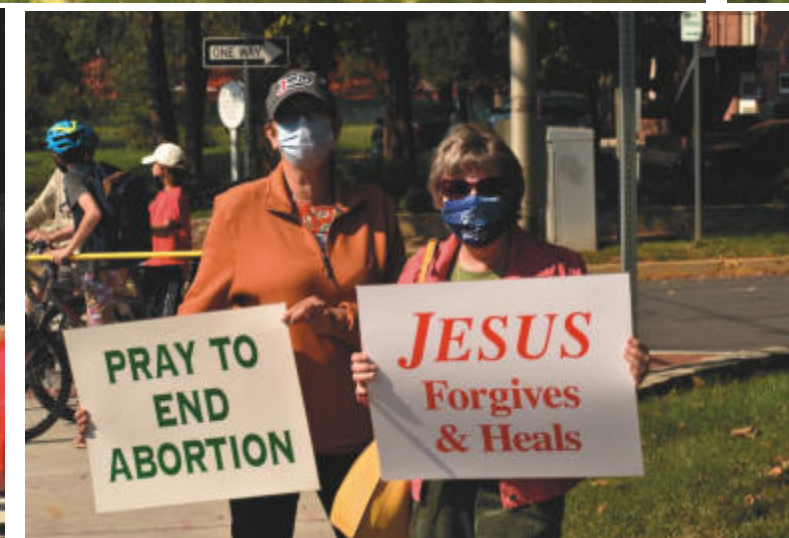

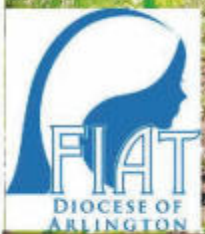

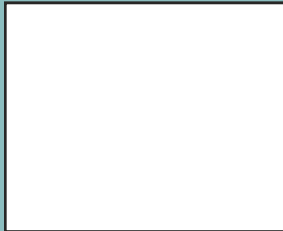
