

On The Way

Catholic Social Doctrine: Option for the poor

A fair gauge of a society's health is how it treats its poor and vulnerable. Pope Leo XIII observed that society cannot exist or be conceived of without "differences and inequalities of condition." As he warned, and as we have seen over the past 150 years, the attempt to eliminate all inequality makes everybody equally miserable. Rather than helping the poor, Marxist and statist solutions both deprive the wealthy of their means to assist and dispense them from their obligation to do so.

Nevertheless, just because inequality is inevitable doesn't mean we can ignore the poor. Indeed, inequalities of condition obligate the wealthy to assist the needy. This obligation holds for the Church, her members, and all of society. It is a matter not only of charity but also of justice. "Love for others, and in the first place love for the poor, in whom the Church sees Christ himself, is made concrete in the promotion of justice" (St. John Paul).

Thus public authorities have a particular duty to the poor and vulnerable. The shaping of legislation and execution of laws should give them special consideration. "The richer class have many ways of shielding themselves, and stand less in need of help from the state; whereas the mass of the poor have no resources of their own to fall back upon, and must chiefly depend upon the assistance of the state" (Leo XIII). "The function of the rulers of the state... is to watch over the community and its parts; but in protecting private individuals in their rights, chief consideration ought to be given to the weak and the poor" (Pius XI).

Now, the mistake commonly made here is to think that this always requires direct state action. In fact, society's care for the poor does not necessarily or always mean state assistance. Here again we encounter the principle of subsidiarity: the state assists only when and where more immediate and local organizations cannot fulfill a need. A healthy state will free up the charitable, volunteer, and private organizations and initiatives that can serve the poor in a more direct, organic, and efficient manner.

This touches on two other principles of social teaching. First, religious freedom. Outside the federal government, our nation's largest provider of social assistance is the Catholic Church. The Church insists on religious freedom for her members so that they can fulfill her Lord's twofold command: to worship (love of God) and to serve (love of neighbor). Employment and health care laws that deny the Church the freedom to serve according to her faith simply sideline our nation's greatest servant of the poor.

Second, the right to life. If we take seriously that the life in the womb is indeed a person, then we have to acknowledge that the poorest and most vulnerable members of our society are the unborn. The most recently available statistics show that 18% percent of pregnancies (excluding miscarriages) in 2017 ended in abortion, a total of 862,320 abortions that year. Taking seriously the rights of the poor demands that we seek justice not only for those we can see but also – and especially – for those hidden in the womb.


Ushers Needed—Please Help


