On The Way

On the way: The Church's Social Doctrine 3/9: the Family "The history of mankind, the history of salvation, passes by way of the family" (St. John Paul II)

Last week's column considered inviolable, transcendent dignity of the human person as a principle of the Church's social teaching. A society is just to the degree that it recognizes and reveres the truth of the human person.

This week we consider that the human person is intrinsically social. Each of us is unrepeatable. But that does not mean that we are to live individualistically. We are meant to live in community. Aristotle describes man as a "political animal." What he meant by that phrase is not that we are made for politics in the modern sense (God forbid!), but that we are meant for the polis, the city-state, the community – to live in common with others.

This is not as self-evident as it seems. Certain philosophies see the human person as an atomized, radically autonomous individual. Hobbes famously described man as "solitary, poor, nasty, brutish, and short." He saw us as individuals at each other's throats. Government is thus established to mitigate our brutal, selfish existence.

Jean-Jacques Rousseau had the opposite view but ended up in the same place. For him our natural state is blissful freedom and innocence. Our living together forces us to give that up and puts us in chains. Notice that both Hobbes and Rousseau view society as something foreign to us, an imposition. These views of man as radically individualistic must be rejected.

The truth is that the human person is intrinsically communal and social. We come into the world only by way of union between a man woman. Our very existence comes from a community. Likewise, we cannot realize our full purpose and fulfillment except in community. Society is not on or enslavement of the human imposition person; it is necessary to human flourishing. "The human person needs to live in society. Society is not for him an extraneous addition but a requirement of his nature. Through the exchange with others, mutual service and dialogue with his brethren, man develops his potential; he thus responds to his vocation" (CCC 1879).

The most fundamental society is the family: "the original cell of social life" (CCC 2207). G.K. Chesterton describes the family "the one anarchist institution" — not because it lacks order or rules (although, sometimes one wonders...) but because it precedes every government in the world. The family thus serves as another check on the government's power. "Civil authority should consider it a grave duty 'to acknowledge the true nature of marriage and the family, to protect and foster them, to safeguard public morality, and promote domestic prosperity" (CCC 2210).

Thus, the Church rejects the definition or acceptance as "marriage" anything other than the union of one man and one woman. This is not because of an irrational animus, as some have claimed. Rather, it is because the truth of the family - man, woman, children - precedes the state and -must always be respected and promoted by the state. - Fr. Scalia

Holy Communion During the Pandemic

As many of you know, since the beginning of the pandemic we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. But as more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- We have placed Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross *farthest* from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross and the minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host. Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.
- Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.
