On The Way

The Church's Social Doctrine 1/9

The old rule is that in polite company you must not speak about religion or politics. We know well that both topics have been the ruin of a great many gatherings of family and friends. The current atmosphere in our country is so charged that few, if any, of us have escaped that reality.

Perhaps I am now rushing in where angels fear to tread, because I intend to speak about both. Beginning with this column, I will explain the Church's Social Doctrine, her teaching on what shapes a just society. I do so to help form consciences and to consider political matters properly, in keeping with the Catholic Faith.

What is the role of the Catholic Church in politics and matters of the state? Should the Church be involved at all? Well, of course she should. Even the Church's enemies recognize this whenever they accuse her of not doing something – not standing up to Hitler, or whatever perceived failure there might be. Often the Church is at one moment criticized for involvement in politics, and then faulted for not doing more.

The Catechism says that it is a part of the Church's mission "to pass moral judgments even in matters related to politics, whenever the fundamental rights of man or the salvation of souls requires it." (CCC 2246). Because the Church has this grave obligation to speak out, she also has the right to do so.

Notice the two reasons given. First, the fundamental rights of man: to bear witness to the truth of the human person as the foundation of a just society. Second, the salvation of souls: to limit the evil in society that threatens eternal salvation.

History gives us examples of the Church's fulfilling this obligation and exercising this right. In 390 Saint Ambrose rebuked Emperor Theodosius for his massacre of civilians in the town of Thessalonica. The bishop even went so far as to bar Theodosius from entering the church until he repented for spilling innocent blood.

In 1937, Pope Pius XI drafted a letter to the people of Germany condemning the evils of Nazism. The letter was smuggled into Germany and read from every Catholic pulpit on the same Sunday. The Nazis confiscated as many copies as they could and called the pope the "Jewish God's vicar in Rome."

The Church does not speak out on everything, because not all issues carry the same moral weight. The vast majority of political issues are matters of prudential judgment. Well-formed Catholics can disagree with each other and still remain good Catholics. Most of the time the Church does not declare a specific policy. She limits herself to teaching the moral principles by which legislators should decide and citizens should vote.

At other times, however, the Church must speak out definitively against intrinsic evils, which can never be endorsed or promoted. In our political landscape such issues would be abortion, same-sex marriage, and religious freedom.

In subsequent columns I will lay out, in keeping with the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the truths and moral principles that ought to guide our thinking, speaking, and voting.


Guided Children's Adoration— September 19
