



On The Way

Typing Lessons

A young man in the parish recently asked about appearances of Christ in the Old Testament. Specifically, did Jesus appear in the Old Testament? The short answer to that is No. The Son of God works throughout the Old Testament, in union with the Father and the Holy Spirit. But the Person of Jesus Christ does not appear in this world until Mary conceives Him in her womb.

However...there is a sense in which our Lord does "appear" in the Old Testament, by way of certain people that prefigure Him. The Old Testament narrative contains people, places, objects, and events that are "types" or images of something in the New Testament. They are historical events acting as prophecies to be fulfilled. Thus, the ancient saying that "the New Testament lies hidden in the Old and the Old Testament is unveiled in the New."

This way of reading scripture is traditionally known as typology. The people, places, and events of the Old Testament maintain their own historical value. But they also point ahead to the time of fulfillment, when the full meaning of what occurred then is revealed in the New Testament. Thus typology "discerns in God's works of the Old Covenant prefigurations of what He accomplished in the fullness of time in the Person of His incarnate Son" (CCC 128).

Each Old Testament type is both similar to and different from its New Testament fulfillment. The similarity reveals to us something more about the Old Testament type. We see it as not only isolated in history but also as a person or event that points forward, to the completion of salvation history. The difference reveals the greatness of the New Testament fulfillment.

We find this manner of interpretation in the New Testament itself. For example, we all know the story of Noah and the Ark (Gen 6-8). Saint Peter tells us that that event "prefigured baptism" (1Pt 3:21). This means that the historical figure Noah is also a "type" or image of Christ. By way of wood and water Noah saved humanity from the punishment for sin. Christ reveals the full meaning of this scene. He now saves humanity through the wood of the Cross and the water of Baptism. The Church has incorporated this interpretation into the Rite of Baptism. In praying over the water, the priest says, "O God, who by the outpouring of the flood foreshadowed regeneration, so that from the mystery of one and the same element of water would come an end to vice and a beginning of virtue."

So also Saint Paul, in Romans, teaches that Adam "was a type of the one who was to come" (Rom 5:14). Developing this point elsewhere, the Apostle explains, "just as in Adam all die, so too in Christ shall all be brought to life" (1 Cor 15:22). Just as we all suffer the effects of Adam's sin, so now we stand to receive the graces of Christ's victory. Indeed, this is central to our faith: to cease being "in Adam" and begin to live "in Christ."

This way of understanding the Old Testament clearly has deep roots in our faith. This column will consider some of the more notable types/prefigurements in the Old Testament so that we can better understand and appreciate the gifts of the New.

This weekend, August 28-29, we have added a second collection for Haiti. The death toll is




Jubilarian Mass
