On The Way

Joseph: Lover of Poverty

We know from the Gospels that Joseph and Mary were among the poor of Israel. At the Presentation of Christ in the Temple they offer "a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons" (Lk 2:24). This offering was a concession of the law to those who could not afford to offer the customary lamb (cf. Lev 12:2-8). It was the poor man's offering.

During their flight into Egypt and their sojourn there, Joseph and Mary would have learned what it means to be in need. And Nazareth to which they returned was not a place of the wealthy and influential but of the poor and no account. "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" (Jn 1:46) Nathaniel asks. His question seems to have been a byword.

But experiencing poverty does not typically make one a lover of poverty. Something more, some interior quality, is needed to see poverty not as just a deprivation but also as an opportunity. We should think of Joseph's love of poverty as what the Church calls "evangelical poverty" – that detachment from created goods that enables us to live more freely for God alone. For us in the world this means a simplicity of life that keeps us from becoming attached to our possessions and also enables us to sacrifice them for the good of the spiritual life.

The reason for this poverty is simple: Christ made Himself poor. "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich" (2 Cor 8:9). Christ's poverty enriches. And Joseph had this example of enriching poverty under his humble roof for thirty years. His love of poverty was inspired by his Son's.

To love poverty means to recognize that all our wealth comes from God. "What have you that you did not receive?" (1 Cor 4:7). Our wealth is not ours to do with as we want. It is entrusted to us for the good of others. And that is surely how Joseph understood every shekel in his possession: not for him but for his wife and Son. Which means that Joseph placed all created goods in the proper perspective. He was not enamored with or distracted by worldly wealth, as we so often are. After all, he had the riches of heaven and earth dwelling under his roof.

This love of poverty does not see destitution or deprivation as good in itself. We must still help the poor and seek to alleviate poverty. No, this love of poverty means to see our lack of something as occasion to rely more on Christ. Our wealth deludes us into thinking that we are sufficient to ourselves. It blinds us to our weakness and our need for Christ. The experience of poverty becomes a blessing insofar as it prompts us to recall our radical dependence on Him.

As is always the case, Joseph's virtues anticipate our Lord's preaching: "Blessed are the poor in spirit... Blessed are you poor" (Mt 5:3; Lk 6:20). Conversely, our Lord would have had in Joseph a noble model and anticipation of the poverty He was to preach.

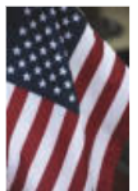

Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

As you know, since the beginning of the pandemic we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross *farthest* from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross. The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.

Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.

Lenten Fasting Requirements

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For Roman Catholics, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Roman Catholics from age 14 onwards.

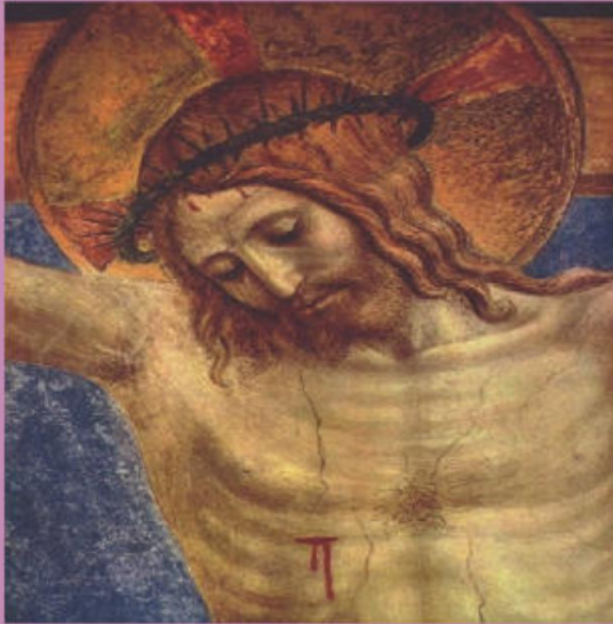



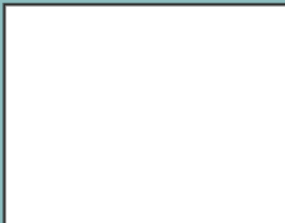
