

# On The Way

# Vexed by Vaccines?

Several vaccines for Covid-19 have been approved in the United States, and others appear to be on the way. The rapid development of these vaccines is an incredible achievement. They give hope for an end to the pandemic. Nevertheless, they also present some moral concerns.

These concerns come from the use of cell lines derived from an abortion in the 1960's in the development of the vaccines. In fact, the Church has already addressed this. Some of the most common vaccines (e.g. for Rubella) were developed using such cell lines. The use of such a vaccine constitutes cooperation in evil. Indeed, some claim that it is absolutely wrong to receive such vaccines. The Church clarified that the reception of such a vaccine would be morally licit although it would still be, in the language of Catholic moral theology, "remote material cooperation in evil."

There are three elements involved in this teaching. First, the cooperation in evil is *remote*. That is, the evil act of abortion is so distant from the person receiving the vaccine that there is no complicity. Second, the cooperation is *material* not formal. That is, the person receiving the vaccine does not share the intention of the person committing the evil act of abortion. Third, there is a sufficient public health *need* for the vaccine.

Several Covid vaccines have been developed from such a morally compromised cell lines (e.g. the AstraZeneca/Oxford). The Moderna and Pfizer vaccines now available in the U.S. were not developed in that manner. However, they did test their vaccines on such a cell line. Applying to the new vaccines the same moral reasoning used previously, both the Vatican and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have taught that it is morally licit to receive the Moderna and Pfizer vaccines.

However, another requirement is to protest this manner of developing vaccines (e.g. by a letter to one's health insurance provider). The Church's statement that it is morally licit to receive such vaccines does not change the fact that doing so is a form of cooperation in evil (albeit material and remote) and that the continued use of such cell lines is immoral. We ought to have another option. A vaccine unconnected to abortion ought to be developed. This is not a hope or desire, but something demanded by the common good.

Further, we need to consider the moral obligations involved when other vaccines become available. We have an obligation to choose (insofar as we are able) the vaccine that has either less of a connection to a morally compromised cell line or none at all. Thus, since the AstraZeneca vaccine is derived from a morally compromised cell line, one must choose instead the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine that was only tested in that manner. Similarly, should a vaccine that has no connection to such a cell line become available, we are morally obligated (again, insofar as we are able) to choose that vaccine over one developed immorally.

The pandemic continues to be a great strain on all of us. Nevertheless, we must not allow our legitimate desire for a solution to override our moral reasoning.



# Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

As you know, since the beginning of the pandemic we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross *farthest* from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross. The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.

Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.




