

## On The Way

Overcoming obstacles

The word "scandal" comes from the Greek skandalon -"obstacle" or "stumbling block." It indicates behavior or speech that blocks people from the truth, leads them into error, and enables them to sin. Thus, when Peter tries to deter Jesus from going to the Cross to fulfill the Father's will, our Lord calls him a "stumbling block" (Mt 16:23).

Consider the Church's sad history with abusive priests and negligent bishops. We describe such men not only as criminal, perverse, and deceitful, but also as scandalous. Their words, actions, and inactions were villainous and for that reason created an obstacle to the truth of the Gospel. They are scandals because they block people from coming to the faith.

Now, we typically think of a scandal as something public and shocking. But that's not necessarily so. If a notoriously bad man does something commonly known as wicked, there is no scandal. We all see it for what it is: a bad man doing bad things. No one is misled. But when an apparently good man makes what is evil seem good, then people are misled and – whether they realize it or not – are scandalized.

With this in mind, I feel obligated to clarify the Church's teachings in contrast to the example of the now United most prominent Catholic in the President-elect Joe Biden (whom one gossip columnist shamelessly dubbed the "Catholic-in-Chief"). Many of his policy proposals are matters of prudential judgment on which good people can disagree. Unfortunately, others involve the promotion of intrinsic evils affecting the very foundations of society: namely, the right to life and the truth of marriage.

President-elect Biden strongly advocates legalized abortion. He pledged to make Roe v. Wade the law of the land in the event that it is overturned by the Supreme Court. He recently endorsed federal funding for abortion and at the same time promised to restore federal funding to Planned Parenthood, the largest abortion provider in the country.

The danger is that some might take President-elect Biden's example to mean that one can both profess the Catholic Faith and advocate legalized abortion. In fact, these two things are diametrically opposed. It is a grave evil and contrary to the Catholic Faith to draft, enact, and enforce laws that give up innocent human life to destruction.

The same holds true for the President-elect's support for "gay marriage." When this was still a legal question, he advocated its legalization and himself officiated at a gay wedding. Again, it must be clarified that his words and actions in this regard contradict the Church's perennial teaching. Marriage is only the permanent and faithful union of a man and a woman.

Since the 2020 campaign is over and Biden has been confirmed as President-elect, it should be clear that this is not intended as a political statement. Rather, it is simply to clarify the Church's saving doctrine in the face of a misleading, and therefore scandalous, example. The President-elect has both a right to and a need for our prayers, especially given the challenges facing our nation. Please do pray for him – that the Lord grant him a conversion of heart as well as the wisdom and strength to serve our nation.

## **Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail**

As you know, since the beginning of the pandemic we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross *farthest* from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross. The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.

Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.


