



On The Way

Catechesis on Creation: the Effects of Original Sin, II

Last week we considered the effects of original sin as they appear in the narrative of Genesis. This week we turn to those punishments not just as perceived by us but as announced by God Himself (Gen 3:14-24).

God begins the announcement of divine punishment with the words, "Because you have done this..." Now, we should not think that His punishments are arbitrary or capricious. No, the punishments fit the crime. They express precisely what man's rebellion against his Creator brings about. The order and harmony that was God's gift to him is now thrown into disorder and disharmony by sin. When man rebels against God, everything else rebels against him. He has brought disorder into the world. Which means that all the disorder we see is ultimately an effect of the first sin. We cannot overstate the cosmic effect of that sin.

Sin damages man's relationships. Consider how the beauty and joy that a mother should experience in childbirth is now marred by pain: "I will greatly multiply your pain in childbearing; in pain you shall bring forth children." The command to "be fruitful and multiply" still remains. But now division and suffering are associated with it.

So also, the harmonious relationship between man and woman is hurt. God says to the woman, "your desire shall be for your husband, and he shall rule over you." The complementarity between man and woman intended by the Creator is now compromised by the element of competition. The headship of the husband – that is, his taking the initiative in caring for his wife – is now marked by domination rather than service. She is no longer his "suitable partner" or "helpmate" but one who envies and covets what he has; a competitor.

Indeed, creation itself is now in rebellion because of man's sin: "Cursed is the ground because of you; in toil you shall eat of it all the days of your life; thorns and thistles it shall bring forth to you; and you shall eat the plants of the field." Although the beauty of nature remains, there is now also a disharmony in the relationship: the created world and man find themselves at odds with one another. Therefore, Saint Paul says that "the creation was subjected to futility" and is in "bondage to decay" (Rom 8:20). Proper concern for the environment must take seriously that the created world suffers on account of our sin. It's not too much to say that the best thing we can do for the environment is to repent.

Related to this is the distortion of the original gift of work (see Gen 2:15). That gift remains, but no longer according to its intended order: "In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread." Labor is now, well, laborious. We find it frustrating, difficult, and even slavish at times.

Most importantly, with sin death enters the world: "you are dust, and to dust you shall return." "The wages of sin is death," Saint Paul tells us (Rom 6:23). Death is the ultimate result of original sin. By rebelling against the Creator, man severed himself and his descendants from the source of life. We labor under the curse of death incurred by sin.


Would you like to discover Christ and His Church? Have you thought about becoming Catholic? Were you baptized Catholic but haven't completed the other


