### *Joseph: Protector of Holy Church*

In 1870 Blessed Pope Pius IX solemnly declared Saint Joseph Patron of the Universal Church. That role and title makes its way into the Litany of Saint Joseph as "Protector of Holy Church." This title rests on two truths about the Church.

First, the Church is far more than just an institution tasked with preserving and promoting the memory of Jesus of Nazareth. She is, of course, the creation of Christ Himself; His Bride and His Body, the extension of His presence throughout history and throughout the world. As such, all that we find in the life of Christ Himself we find also in the life of the Church. Thus, just as our Lord was placed under the protection of Saint Joseph, so also the Church now enjoys that protection.

Second, the continuity between holiness in this world and glory in the next means that the saints continue in heaven the same mission they had on earth. Now, Saint Joseph is a man for all seasons, able to be invoked for any kind of need. But just as he had a particular role in protecting Christ while in this world, so now in heaven he shows particular solicitude for the defense of Christ's Body, the Church.

This means also that the occasion and the manner of Joseph's protection of our Lord reveals what he accomplishes now for the Church. Saint Joseph protects first of all in a most ordinary way: he guards Jesus and Mary from material want and need. The more conspicuous protection is from the evil of King Herod: "[A]n angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, 'Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there till I tell you; for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him.'"

Herod was jealous of his power, so mentality insecure about his own place that he lashed out at mere children to maintain his petty kingdom. Herod was a type of what the Church would have to face throughout her history: men who assaulted the Church less because of her theology and more because she was an inconvenience, an obstacle to the accumulation and exercise of power. Most of the name are lost in history, but some are well known to us: Nero, Domitian, Stalin, Castro, Chavez, etc.

As we consider Saint Joseph spiriting Jesus and Mary away from Herod's soldiers, so we ask him to guard us. This is indeed a timely consideration, which is why Pius IX had the inspiration to give Joseph that title. There were more martyrs for the Catholic faith in the last century than in the rest of the Church's history combined. As I write this Pope Francis is in Iraq, where the Church has suffered both an overt and a more subtle persecution.

In our own country the threats to religious freedom have only increased in the last few months. Not that the Church will be eliminated in this country, yet. But the Church's ability to live her life and do her works are certainly being threatened. All the more reason for us to go to Joseph, Protector of Holy Church, and ask him to secure protection for us, "that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life, godly and respectful in every way" (1 Tm 2:2).

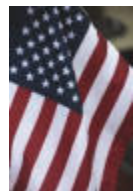

## Church During COVID-19

In keeping with the Governor's executive orders, please observe social distancing and wear a mask when in the church.

### Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

Since the beginning of the pandemic, we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross farthest from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross.
- The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.
- Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.

## Lenten Fasting Requirements

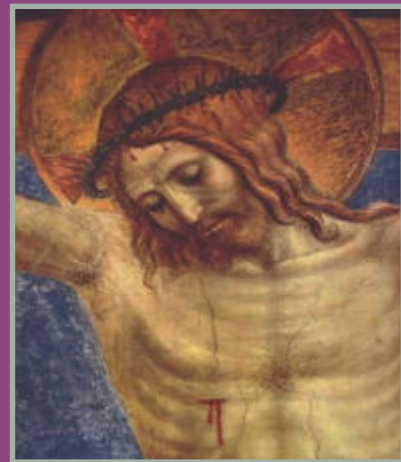
Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For Roman Catholics, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Roman Catholics from age 14 onwards.

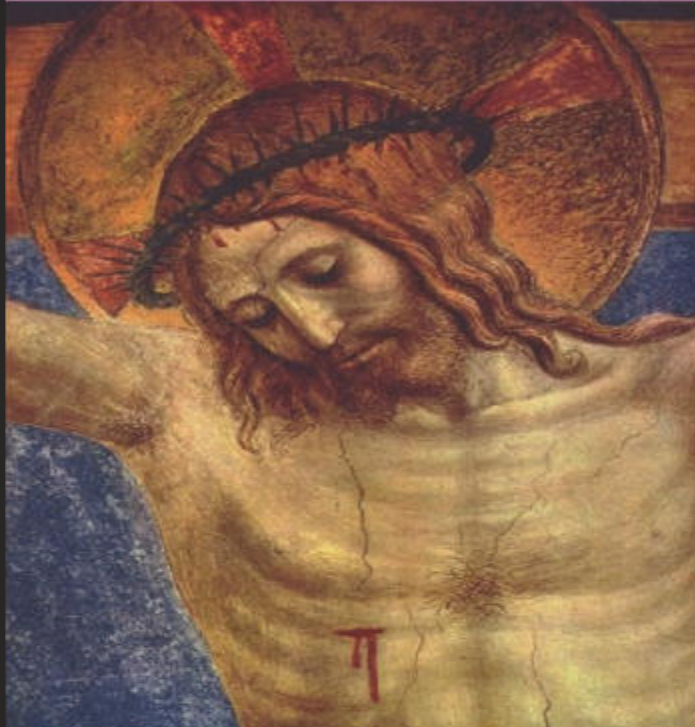

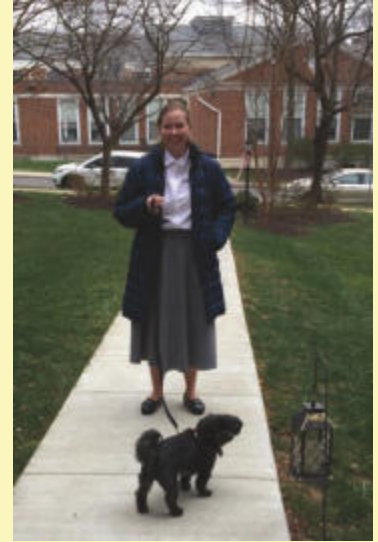

## Getting to Know IHM Postulant Alexis Reavill

On Saturday, January 9, St. James welcomed Alexis Reavill, a Postulant in the Order of the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (IHM). Alexis, a 2020 graduate of Immaculata University, in Malvern, PA, with a Bachelor of Music degree. Her primary instrument is the viola. The IHM Order sent Alexis here to learn more about what being an IHM Sister is. As a Postulant, Alexis is in the first year of her eight-year journey to be a fully professed IHM Sister. Since here, she has learned what life in a convent is like, living and praying with the sisters. She has filled her days with teaching music classes and lessons, doing morning temperature checks, making copies for students – what she was doing when our interview began – and generally helping out around the school wherever her help is needed.

Alexis' journey didn't just start on January 9 of this year; it started in Phoenixville, PA, when, as a fifth-grader at Villa Maria Academy, an all-girls Catholic school that the IHM order administers, she met IHM Sisters. When Alexis entered Immaculata University, administered by the IHM order, she knew three things: "I knew I loved music, that my faith was important to me, and I loved doing service." But, she was not yet thinking of being a nun. Until, on a service trip, as part of her orientation week, an IHM sister came around to photograph the service groups, "and a lightbulb went off," that being a Sister would allow her to do all three things she loved, "and I started to think about the religious life." She started to take part in Sisters' Nights and Discernment Retreats, giving her the chance to meet with IHM Sisters to explore their daily lives, pray with them, and socialize with the sisters and other young women who were also discerning vocations. All of these experiences inspired her to join the IHM order and start to pursue becoming a fully-professed Sister.

After Alexis leaves St. James on March 27, her journey toward being a fully professed sister is just beginning. At the end of the summer of 2021, she will become a Novice in the order – taking on her religious name and the title of "Sister." For the next two years, she will engage in prayer and



discernment, learning about the order's vows of chastity, poverty, obedience, and learning more about the IHM Order. In her third year, when she is a Senior Novice, she will "get a chance to go out on a 12-week mission to teach, and to see how the living the vows really works." After her third year, she will profess temporary vows and continue life as an IHM Sister. At the end of that period, she will face a choice – "you can say, 'this is not for me' and leave with no penalties, or you can decide to make final vows." Alexis stressed that the eight-year process is structured to allow those who profess final vows are to be very sure they are in the right place and doing what God intends them to be doing.

Alexis' has this piece of advice in regard to vocations – "if you are thinking about a vocation, understand that you are not alone. You are not the first person to think about that, and there are others out there, right now, thinking the same thoughts. So don't hold back if you discern a call – it's normal to explore religious life if you feel you are being called."

We thank the IHM Order for sending Alexis to be part of our community here at St. James, and we wish her all the best as she continues on her path to final vows. Please keep Alexis and all who are pursuing religious vocations in your daily prayers.
