

#### On The Way

#### Gender Ideology

In his encyclical Amoris Laetitia (issued five years ago), Pope Francis warned the world against "an ideology of gender" that was gaining ground. Since that warning, and especially in the last few months, gender ideology has not only gained ground but has become the dominant political and cultural issue. Last month the House passed the radical and ill-named Equality Act. The bill's legal implications are considerable and frightening.

But of greater concern to me as a priest is the damage that the codification of gender ideology would do to our understanding of the human person and, in particular, of the body. Make no mistake, the law is a teacher. If passed and enacted, the bill would inevitably impact the way our country thinks about such fundamentals as human nature, sexuality, and the body.

Many people in our culture think of the human person as a soul with a body. That's wrong. The human person is (in philosophical terms) an embodied soul, a body/soul unity; one organism consisting of a body and a soul. The two are created for one another to form a composite whole called the human person.

Yes, we all experience a certain disharmony between our body and soul. They don't always get along. Unlike the Gnostics of the ancient world, however, we do not conclude from this disharmony that the body is somehow bad. No, we understand the disharmony as an effect of original sin. Our conviction is that the body and soul are created to be for one another. This means that we have to strive to bring the body and soul into harmony by accepting the limitations of our body and by training it for its noble calling.

This oneness of body and soul is in evidence nowhere else more than in Catholic worship and sacraments. The entire system of Catholic liturgy rests on the conviction that the body and the soul are one. Grace is communicated to our souls by outward – i.e. bodily – signs.

This is true most of all in the Sacrament of Sacraments, the Eucharist. Our reception of Holy Communion should confirm in our minds the real-though-wounded union of body and soul. Far from being an obstacle to the spiritual life, our body is the means by which we are united to Christ's Body. Indeed, the Eucharist is the "pledge of eternal life," of heaven itself, where we will experience the perfect reintegration - and glorification – of body and soul.

Gender ideology says something different. It posits a dichotomy, separation, and even hostility between the body and the soul. Accordingly, someone can be biologically/physically male or female but have an "internal sense" of being the opposite. This is more than disharmony; this is contradiction. Suddenly, the body has no meaning. It tells us nothing about ourselves. Worse still, the body lies to us. It tells us that we are something than we really are - hence the need for "transitioning."

Dear friends, please take time to educate yourself on this

matter with trustworthy material. For websites, I recommend Canavox.com and Personandidentity.com For books, I recommend Ryan Anderson's When Harry Met Sally as an excellent survey of this issue. Although cancelled by Amazon, this book is still available from the publisher's website: Encounterbooks.com In Irreversible Damage, reporter Abigail Shrier examines how the errors of gender ideology disproportionately impact young women.

#### **Church During COVID-19**

In keeping with the Governor's executive orders, please observe social distancing and wear a mask when in the church.

#### Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

Since the beginning of the pandemic, we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross farthest from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross.
- The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.
- Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.

#### **Lenten Fasting Requirements**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.


For Roman Catholics, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Roman Catholics from age 14 onwards.


