

On The Way

Sorrow for Sin

Today we enter into Holy Week and draw close to our Lord in His suffering. It is the most important time for all to cultivate the proper sorrow for our sins. A simple but profitable exercise in this regard is to spend time with the traditional Act of Contrition and its meaning.

O my God... This is no perfunctory introduction. It sets the terms of the entire prayer by its simple expression of the parties involved. We appeal to God Himself, Who alone can free us from sin. Each of us says my God. Not mine because I control Him but because of that relationship He has established; because I am His.

I am heartily sorry... The heart here signifies more than just feelings. It expresses the biblical understanding of the heart as the center of the person. We are sorry not necessarily because of our emotions (although that would be nice) but because on a deeper, more profound level we acknowledge our sins.

...for having offended Thee... We have not merely transgressed a law, rule, or command. We have offended someone. We have disrupted a relationship.

... and I detest all my sins... To love God means to love what he loves...and to hate what He hates. Contrition is more than regret. It involves a rejection and detestation of our sins. We hate them because they hurt us and our relationship with God.

...because of Thy just punishments... unfortunately, the modern concept of religion doesn't leave much room for the reality of punishment. There is a punishment written into sin itself, because it separates us from our source of life and love. Moreover, since sin is a rebellion against God's order, there are punishments (temporal and eternal) to restore the order disturbed by sin. This is imperfect (not bad, but imperfect) contrition. If it's all that we can muster, then the grace of the Sacrament supplies the rest.

...but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, who art all good and deserving of all my love. Here is the highest kind of sorrow: perfect contrition, or the contrition of love. We detest our sins not just because they merit punishment but because we have hurt the One Who loves us perfectly. This is the contrition we should pray to have, the contrition that Christ's Sacred Heart has on our behalf before the Father.

I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace to sin no more... It means nothing to us if someone apologizes but has no intention of correcting his behavior. So also, our sorrow before God without the resolution to avoid sin is meaningless. But don't confuse this resolution with perfect holiness. This resolution is on the level of the will. We know that we are weak and may very well (perhaps very quickly) fall into sin again. But that is not our desire or will. Of course, as the prayer says, we depend on His grace to fulfill the resolution.

...and to avoid the near occasion of sin. We go even further. We not only want to avoid sin, we want to avoid those things that lead us there. Of course, this is just common sense.

Please make note of our extra times for confession during Holy Week. If you have not done so already this Lent, make sure you make a good Confession before Easter.



Church During COVID-19

In keeping with the Governor's executive orders, please observe social distancing and wear a mask when in the church.

Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

Since the beginning of the pandemic, we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross farthest from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross.
- The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.
- Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.

Lenten Fasting Requirements

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.


For Roman Catholics, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Roman Catholics from age 14 onwards.






