On The Way

Joseph: Terror of Demons

Perhaps the most intriguing title for Saint Joseph is Terror of Demons. It sounds so menacing, as if he were bearing down on every fallen angel. It could be the stuff of an action movie: St. Joseph, Terror of Demons. Starring Chuck Norris.

But the opposite is true. Joseph, the Terror of Demons, is hidden and silent. And it is precisely those qualities that terrify the demons.

We must understand that God's greatest works are hidden. St. Ignatius of Antioch says, "[T]he virginity of Mary was hidden from the prince of this world, as was also her offspring, and the death of the Lord; three mysteries of renown...were wrought in silence by God." These mysteries are veiled from the devil so as to become his undoing. And Joseph is the veil.

St. Augustine uses the image of a mousetrap to describe this phenomenon: "The devil exulted when Christ died, but by this very death of Christ the devil was vanquished, as if he had swallowed the bait in the mousetrap...What he rejoiced in was then his own undoing. The cross of the Lord was the devil's mousetrap; the bait by which he was caught was the Lord's death."

Inspired by this, the Mérode Altarpiece shows Joseph in his workshop carving a mousetrap. It's a fitting depiction, because Joseph had an essential role in this hidden work. In his workshop he shaped the Man who would trap the evil one.

This, then, is the Terror of Demons: the man whose modesty conceals their greatest foes, who blinds them to the One Who conquers them. As Jacques-Bénigne Bossuet puts it, "The apostles are lights to show Jesus Christ to the world; Joseph is a veil to cover him and, behind this veil, Mary's virginity and the greatness of the Savior of souls are hidden."

St. Joseph veiled Jesus and Mary for a time. In the fullness of time, the veil was removed, and our Lord accomplished His mission, proclaiming the Kingdom of God, and overthrowing that of the devil.

This speaks of the power of modesty, which prompts us to retreat from the public eye, to be hidden and veiled. The modest man has no need of the attention, much less the approval, of others.

In modesty – under the veil that was Joseph – God's greatest weapons were hidden. Likewise, our fight against evil needs this simple, unassuming virtue. If we go chasing after the attention of others (as our culture encourages us to do), we will soon forget to rejoice in the attention of God. And the demons laugh when we call attention to ourselves for at those moments we have taken attention away from God.

Joseph, Terror of Demons would make a lousy action movie. Because Joseph called no attention to himself. He said nothing for himself or his own. He veiled them by his presence – giving the glory to God, not himself. In his final act of modesty, he exits at the proper time. His death is the unveiling, the time for the New Adam and the New Eve to step forward and crush the head of the prince of demons.

Church During COVID-19

In keeping with the Governor's executive orders, please observe social distancing and wear a mask when in the church.

Receiving Communion at the Communion Rail

Since the beginning of the pandemic, we have been distributing Holy Communion at the altar rail. We find this helps us distribute Communion both reverently and safely. As more people return to Mass it also might take some getting used to. Please make note of these instructions.

- There are Crosses six feet apart along the step of the rail.
- When coming forward for Communion, please go to the Cross farthest from you in your section (i.e. in the center or on the sides).
- Stand or kneel at that Cross.
- The minister will bring you Communion.
- If receiving Communion in the hand, please remove your mask first, then receive the Host.
- Consume the Host while at the altar rail and then return to your seat.
- Please remember that members of the same household do not have to practice social distancing and may stand (or kneel) together at the rail.
- Once those in the transepts have received, those coming down the main aisle should use the spaces on the sides of the communion rail as well as the front.

Lenten Fasting Requirements

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.


For Roman Catholics, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Roman Catholics from age 14 onwards.





March Prayer Intention of Pope Francis

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Let us pray that we may experience the sacrament of reconciliation with renewed depth, to taste the infinite mercy of God.


