





On The Way

Technology and the Tree: False Promises

To their sadness and ours, Adam and Eve learned that the devil's promise - "You will be like God" - was both too good to be true...and too true to be good. They did become like God, in the sense that they seized His prerogatives. But they didn't become like Him in the way they thought, with His authority. That is a fair description of technology's promises. Obviously, our technology is not intrinsically evil, as was eating the forbidden fruit. Still, it makes promises both too good to be true and too true to be good.

Communication. The promise was that we will communicate better. Our technology certainly delivers on this. By phone, text, zooming, etc. we can reach one another practically anywhere and at any time. But these forms of communication are merely approximations and not the real thing. They serve as stopgaps until we can have real human communication, which is always face to face. Communication should lead to communion.

The problem arises when we allow the approximation and stop-gap to replace the reality. The past year has only exacerbated this temptation to prefer the simplicity of devices to the challenge of reality. We've all seen families at restaurants, each member focused on his or her phone. Worse still, people forsake real relationships and spend hours on social media, gaming, etc. Thus this "communication" has also produced isolation.

Freedom. Technology promised greater freedom. We would be able to get away from the office and remain on top of things. The smart phone became a sign of freedom. But, as many of us now experience, our smart phones and now our smart watches serve as chains. We're not free but now required to be in contact at all times. We have fewer and fewer spaces that allow us a life without being in contact.

Information. On one hand, our digital technology has delivered the promise of more information. We live in the age of big data, stats, metrics, etc. There is a benefit to his. But information does not mean knowledge and knowledge does not mean wisdom. Technology can only provide information, but it cannot make sense of it. Indeed, the supply of information without a way of interpreting it is dangerous.

On the other hand, as we have learned over the past year, technology's promise of information is false. We don't have access to whatever information we want. Big Tech doles out information on its own terms, not ours. It censors and filters as it sees fit, pretending to give us information while simultaneously denying it to us. We have also learned how big Tech's algorithms just send us spiraling down into our own interests, confirming our biases and further dividing us.

Efficiency. The promise was that our new technology would enable us to get more things done more quickly. In many ways, that has come true. At the same time, efficiency has been achieved at the cost of discretion, manners, and courtesy. Because we can do so quickly – and without thinking – we email, post, or tweet observations and comments that we would never do if we had to sit and think about it.

More importantly, this promise has changed what we value. It has placed efficiency over other, more important principles. The most important things in our life are not efficient. Relationships, prayer, worship – those all take time and patience.


Social Outreach Advent Season Gift Card Donations


