On The Way

Typology: Eve as an Antitype of Mary

Early in his papacy, Pope Francis called attention to a devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title "Untier of Knots." Although new to many of us, this devotion is rooted in one of the earliest titles for Mary: the New Eve or the Second Eve. Whereas Eve was called "the mother of all the living" (Gen 3:20), Mary is the new and true mother of the living.

Eve is not so much a type as an *anti*-type of Mary. They do have similarities: both are virgins, visited by angels, and respond to the angels. But the similarities between them only serve to highlight their differences: Eve is proud and Mary is humble; Eve disbelieves, Mary believes; Eve disobeys, Mary obeys. Eve's sin and rebellion embody the opposite of our Lady's virtues and holiness. Conversely, this means that Mary doesn't so much fulfil what we find in Eve as she undoes – or unties – it. What we find as binding and enslaving in Eve emerges as freeing and salvific in the Virgin Mary. She undoes the knot of disobedience, pride, and rebellion tied by Eve.

The most ancient and complete expression of this comes quite early in the Church's history. In the 2nd century St. Irenaeus of Lyons wrote: "[Jesus'] obedience on the tree of the cross reversed the disobedience at the tree in Eden; the good news of the truth announced by an angel to Mary, a virgin subject to a husband, undid the evil lie that seduced Eve, a virgin espoused to a husband. As Eve was seduced by the word of an angel and so fled from God after disobeying his word, Mary in her turn was given the good news by the word of an angel, and bore God in obedience to his word. As Eve was seduced into disobedience to God, so Mary was persuaded into obedience to God; thus the Virgin Mary became the advocate of the virgin Eve."

In the 5th century, Saint John Chrysostom continued this thought: "[By] the very means by which the devil had conquered, by these Christ conquered him; and taking up the weapons with which he had fought, he defeated him. Listen to how it was done. A virgin, a tree and a death were the symbols of our defeat. The virgin was Eve: she had not yet known man; the tree was the tree of the knowledge of good and evil; the death was Adam's penalty. But behold again a Virgin and a tree and a death, those symbols of defeat, become the symbols of his victory. For in place of Eve there is Mary; in place of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, the tree of the Cross; in place of the death of Adam, the death of Christ."

The Church's tradition sums all of this up in the ancient phrase, "Death through Eve, life through Mary." Writers have delighted in the play on the Latin words at the Annunciation: the archangel Gabriel greets Mary with the word "Ave" which is "Eva" in reverse. In short, just as sin came into the world through a woman, so salvation comes into the world as well. Nor is this left to the past. As our mother in the order of grace, she desires to continue undoing knots for us, her children.

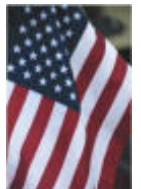

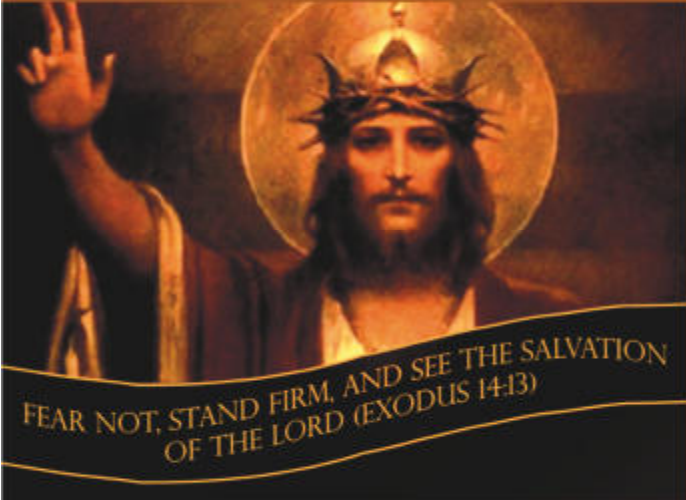
Parish Picnic
