



#### On The Way

Typology: The Ark as a Type of Mary

Thanks to Indiana Jones, most of us know at least a little bit about the ark of the covenant. But we probably don't appreciate the enormous importance it held for ancient Israel.

The ark was the most sacred object in their history. Constructed at the command of God, it was a wooden chest, overlaid with gold on the inside and outside. Its cover had carvings of two angels facing one another. Between them was the "propitiatory" or "favorable place," from which God would communicate with Israel.

The ark was primarily intended to hold the "testimony," or the tablets of the law Moses received on Mount Sinai. Further, as the letter to the Hebrews explains, the ark also contained the golden jar containing manna and the staff of Aaron the high priest (Heb 9:4). Thus it carried and in effect made present the law of the covenant by which they became God's People, the nourishment He gave them, and the priesthood He established for worship. It served as a summary of Israel's relationship with God, the visible sign of God's continuing presence and protection.

The ark traveled in the center of the Israelites when they journeyed through the wilderness and even went with them into battle. Israel's most sacred site, the Temple in Jerusalem was built specifically for the ark, which occupied the Holy of Holies. It was there, before the ark, that the high priest would offer sacrifice for the people's sins every year. Of course, once the Israelites treated the ark as merely a talisman or good luck charm, it was taken from them. Ultimately, when they persevered in their infidelity, Jerusalem was captured, the Temple was destroyed, and the ark was lost to them forever.

The Blessed Virgin Mary is known as the "Ark of the Covenant." Perhaps the better title would be "Ark of the *New*" Covenant." In the book of Revelation John has a vision of the ark of the covenant that he immediately associates with the woman "clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars" (Rev 11:19-12:1).

It might seem more than a little insulting to compare our Lady to an inanimate object. But that would be to get the analogy all wrong. It is not the ark that gives Mary dignity but she who reveals the true dignity of the ark. If it weren't for her, the ark would remain just an interesting relic of history. As it is, the ark maintains significance because it points to her and is fulfilled and surpassed in her, in the same way a picture of a loved one has value because of the person it points to.

Mary is the ark of the new covenant. This ark is not simply an object carrying other objects. This ark is a living person who conceives, nourishes, and bears another Person, the Son of God. And as our Lady surpasses the wooden ark of Israel, so also the Person she carries surpasses its contents. The ark held tablets, bread, and a staff. Our Lady bears the One Who fulfills what all three signify: the One Who is the Law Himself, Who is the Bread of Life, and Who is the eternal High Priest.
