On The Way

Typology: The Ark as a Type of Mary, continued

Last week we considered the Old Testament's Ark of the Covenant as a type of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The sanctity and importance of Israel's ark give us a way of understanding our Lady's sanctity and importance.

One scene in the history of the ark has particular significance. Once King David had secured the kingdom of Israel and established Jerusalem as its capital, he brought the ark to the city. The procession of the ark to Jerusalem (2 Sam 6) has profound and illustrative parallels to Mary's visit to Elizabeth (Lk 1:39-56).

The Ark traveled to the hill country of Judah and remained in the house of Obed-edom (2 Sam 6:1-11) = Mary arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a city of Judah, and she entered the house of Zechariah (Lk 1:39-40)

And David was afraid of the LORD that day; and he said, "How can the ark of the Lord come to me?" (2 Sam 6:9) = Elizabeth said, And why is this granted me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? (Lk 1:43)

David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the Lord with shouting, and with the sound of the horn (2 Sam 6:15). = Elizabeth exclaimed with a loud cry, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb!" (Lk 1:42)

David danced before the Lord with all his might (2 Sam 6:14) = Elizabeth said, For behold, when the voice of your greeting came to my ears, the babe in my womb leaped for joy (Lk 1:44).

And the ark of the Lord remained in the house of O'bede'dom the Gittite three months (2 Sam 6:11) = And Mary remained with her about three months, and returned to her home (Luke 1:56).

These are more than just interesting parallels. They reveal how we should think about our Lady's sanctity. The ark of the covenant was the most sacred object of ancient Israel. But the Ark of the New Covenant surpasses the sanctity of its type as a person's dignity surpasses that of an

All of this means that we should give Our Lady just as much importance in our devotion and worship as the Israelites gave to the ark. It was for them the means by which the Lord came and abided with them. The ark accompanied them in their journey to the Promised Land and went with them in battle against their foes.

So also our Lady, by conceiving and bearing Jesus, makes God present to us. She is the one by whom He comes and abides with us. As such she is, as Pope Saint Paul VI says, "intrinsic to Christian worship." She accompanies us in our pilgrimage to heaven and is with us in our battle – against the vice within ourselves and evil in the world.




