



On The Way

Typing Lessons: David as a Type of Christ

One of the most curious and yet important titles for our Lord is "Son of David." It is curious because, well, Jesus is not literally the son of David. It is important because the Messiah was expected to be a descendant of David, the fulfillment of the prophecy: "Your own offspring I will set upon your throne" (Ps 132:11). In addition to being our Lord's forefather, David is also a type of the Messiah. What we find in the life of David anticipates and makes present the characteristics of the Messiah. "Son of David" indicates not only fulfillment of the prophecy but also of the type.

We first encounter David when the prophet Samuel finds him and anoints him with oil: "Then Samuel, with the horn of oil in hand, anointed him in the midst of his brothers, and from that day on, the spirit of the Lord rushed upon David" (1 Sm 16:13). Thus, David is an "anointed one" – that is, a "messiah."

Perhaps the first thing most of us learn about David is his defeat of Goliath. Two details of that account are important to recall. First, that the boy David foregoes the armor and arms offered to him by the king to battle the giant. He prefers his simple shepherd clothes and slingshot. Second, that for the battle David selects five smooth stones from the brook.

David was the great king of Israel. He united all tribes of Israel and established Jerusalem as the holy city. And yet it is still David the simple shepherd (as God reminds him) who reigns over Israel. In David we encounter the servant leader, the shepherd-king who reigns over the People of God. Finally, David's kingship is ordered toward proper worship. He brings the ark of the covenant to Jerusalem and lays up supplies for building the Temple.

These events announce and make present Christ, the Son of David. He is, first of all, *the* Christ, anointed not by a mere man and with oil but by God Himself and the Holy Spirit (cf. Lk 4:18). David's battle against Goliath points us to the manner in which our Lord defeats the evil one. As David rejected the armor and arms of Saul, so Jesus foregoes both His divine power and all trappings of human power as well. He enters into battle with the devil by way of His simple, humble, sacred humanity.

Further, just as David selects five smooth stones for battle, so our Lord battles the evil one with the five wounds received in His Passion. That account of David reveals our Lord's five wounds to be not wounds of defeat but weapons of victory.

As Jesus makes clear, what we see as an image in David, we encounter perfectly in Him: "I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" (Jn 10:11). He is the definitive shepherd-king, Who reigns over us gently, caring for us as a shepherd cares for his flock. And, just as David established proper worship in Jerusalem, so our Lord reigns over us so that we can offer the proper and perfect worship of the Father. As King He now reigns in heaven the New Jerusalem, to bring us into that perfect liturgy.




