



Typing Lessons: Isaac as a Type of Christ

Perhaps the most difficult story in scripture is the account in Genesis 22 traditionally known as the "Binding of Isaac." It is the telling of Abraham's bringing Isaac to Mount Moriah to offer him in sacrifice, in obedience to God's command. The story is practically impossible to explain fully. But one way - indeed, the best way - to make sense of it is to understand Isaac as a type or prefigurement of Christ.

In the account, God commands Abraham, "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering upon one of the mountains of which I shall tell you." Note that Isaac is described as Abraham's only and beloved son. He is also the son of the covenant, the one promised by God and through whom God will continue the line of Abraham and fulfill His promises.

Abraham travels with Isaac three days. Which means that Isaac is as good as dead for three days. When Abraham ascends the mountain. Isaac follows him carrying on his back the wood for the fire. At one point Isaac asks, "Where is the lamb for the burnt offering?" Abraham mysteriously replies, "God will provide himself the lamb for a burnt offering." When they arrive at the sight of sacrifice, Abraham binds Isaac, goes to cut his throat, but is stopped at the last moment by the angel of God. Spying a ram in the thickets nearby, Abraham offers that animal in sacrifice instead.

This chapter is strong medicine, meant to break Abraham and his descendants of any notion of human sacrifice. But more than that, it also looks to the future. By way of the account, God prepares the minds and hearts of the readers to grasp what He Himself does later. Abraham bluntly prophesies the coming of Christ: "God will provide." But the entire narrative announces by types the sacrifice of Christ.

Remember, every type and fulfillment have similarities that enable us to associate them with each other and differences between them that highlight Christ's superiority. Isaac is clearly a type or figure of Christ – Who is the eternal Father's only and beloved Son...Who carries the wood of the Cross up the mountain of Calvary...Who is bound to the Cross for sacrifice.

Isaac is the only and beloved son who was *not* sacrificed. Thus, the primary and obvious lesson of the story is that, unlike the gods of the surrounding nations, God will never ask His people to offer their children in sacrifice. They can place complete trust in Him because He does not desire their destruction.

But the differences between them reveals even more. Christ is the only and beloved *eternal Son* of the Father Who in obedience to His Father allows Himself to be bound and sacrificed. Thus, the ultimate meaning of this type is, as Abraham says, that God Himself provides. He is not a god who desires human sacrifice. Rather, He is the God Who Himself provides the Sacrifice of His beloved and onlybegotten Son. Just Isaac's deliverance from death preserved the covenant with Abraham, so our Lord's sacrifice established the new and eternal covenant.


Parish Religious Education Program (PREP) for High School
