



On The Way

Typing Lessons: Moses as a Type of Christ

Moses is the most important figure in Israel's history. He presides over the events that define Israel: deliverance from Egypt, passing through the Red Sea, journeying through the desert and to the promised land. He gave them the Ten Commandments, water from the rock, and manna in the desert. Most importantly establishes the covenant with the Lord.

At the end of his life, Moses told the Israelites, "The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brethren -- him you shall heed" (Dt 18:15). For centuries, that prophecy occupied the minds of the Israelites. They awaited one who would be like him. Thus, Moses set the pattern of what the Messiah would be. Some considered Jesus to be the fulfillment of this prophecy. Hence the Pharisees asked Him, "Are you the prophet?" (Jn 1:21).

Our Lord is indeed the fulfillment not only of Moses's prophecy but of the pattern that Moses set. The reality of the Messiah is already made present and revealed in the life of Moses. So, when He arrives, our Lord speaks and acts in ways that clearly point back to Moses and reveal Himself as the fulfillment of the type. There are many, but let's focus on

First, teaching. Moses went up Mount Sinai to receive the Law, the Ten Commandments. These were the heart of Israel's covenant with the Lord. So, when our Lord begins His public ministry, He does so in a manner meant to reveal Himself as a New Moses bringing a new law and a new covenant. Jesus "went up on the mountain" and announces the Beatitudes, the heart of the new covenant (Mt 5:1-12).

Second, nourishment. Under Moses's leadership the Israelites were fed with manna in the desert for forty years. The Jews in our Lord's day expected the Messiah to repeat the miraculous feeding. Thus, when Jesus multiplies bread in the desert for the multitudes, they are immediately reminded of Moses and the one to come. They press Him: "[W]hat sign do you do, that we may see, and believe you? ...Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written, 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat." (Jn 6:30-31).

Jesus is the fulfillment that surpasses the type. "Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven; my Father gives you the true bread from heaven" (Jn 6:32). Moses provided bread that nourished them physically and ceased after forty years. Jesus gives Himself as the Bread of eternal life.

Third, intercession. At various times we hear of Moses interceding for the Israelites. Most conspicuously, after the Israelites fall into idolatry Moses goes back up Mount Sinai to fast for forty days. He intercedes to turn God's punishment away from them. He even goes so far as to offer his life for them.

What we find provisionally in Moses we find definitively in our Lord. Moses fasted and offered himself for the Israelites. Our Lord goes into the desert to fast for days and to offer His life for the sins of the whole world. Moses's offering of his life was insufficient. Our Lord's, because He is the Son of God, is perfect and superabundant.


