



On The Way

Adoration of the Shepherds and Magi

Forgive me as I continue Christmas reflections on adoration for a week or two more. In some places Christmas season is extended to February 2nd, so I think I'm on solid ground!

Outside of the Holy Family, the first people on the scene of Christ's birth were the shepherds. After hearing the angelic announcement, they hasten to Bethlehem and find the baby wrapped in swaddling clothes. The simplicity of what they encounter could seem a disappointment. In contrast to the heavenly host they had seen and heard, they come upon a quiet, humble scene of an infant in a manger. No angelic voices, no heavenly glory. Just the simplicity of a mother and child.

But the shepherds would not have been disappointed. They would have been honored and humbled because their Savior came as one like them. The shepherds, whom we depict as rustic and bucolic, were outcasts in that culture. Living among their flock, they were unwashed and unkempt, not rustic but rough men. They were considered so uncivilized that their testimony was inadmissible in legal proceedings. And yet the Savior – the *Shepherd* of Israel – came to them first and, like them, as one cast out. In their adoration they savor the likeness that God had established between them and himself. It is a sign of his love and that he indeed delights to be with them and one of them.

When we adore our Lord in the Eucharist, we adore him as both God and man; not only as God but also as one of us. The sacred humanity of the Son of God is to be adored precisely because it his. We should share the same sentiments of the shepherds, realizing the great honor and dignity he bestows on us by continuing to dwell with us as one of us. We should be cleaner and more civilized than the shepherds. Still, we too are outcasts, alienated from our own human dignity by sin. By remaining with us as one of us, Christ reveals his love and honors our fallen but redeemed human nature.

Some days later the magi arrive. Their learning and ability to identify and track the new star indicates that, unlike the shepherds, they are men of wealth and power. So, we depict them in our nativity scenes as coming in a retinue, with extravagant robes and crowns, etc. What a contrast and even rebuke our infant Lord presents to them. They arrive in pomp and splendor and find the poor humble child.

If the shepherds adore God as one like them, the magi adore God who is different and calls them to be different. The shepherds' adoration has the tone of gratitude that God became one of them. The wise men's adoration has the character of conversion. In the Christ child they discover the true meaning of kingship, wealth, influence, learning, and power. All the gifts they have are not meant for themselves but for others. True kingship and power are found in the capacity to humbly give oneself.

In our adoration of Christ in the Eucharist, we too find a call to conversion of heart. We cannot exalt ourselves over others when he has humbled himself for us. His humble Eucharistic presence rebukes our pride and calls us to use whatever power and wealth we have not for ourselves but for others.






Parish Library Volunteers Needed




