#### On The Way

The Adoration of the Blessed Virgin Mary

One of the finest paintings in the National Gallery of Art's permanent collection is Giorgione's *The Adoration of the Shepherds*. It's a beautiful depiction of those rustic men coming to visit our Lord on Christmas morning. Another painting in the collection is Botticelli's *The Adoration of the Magi*. Although not as good as Giorgione's, it points us to the same truth: adoration of the infant Christ.

Naturally, both paintings give the Blessed Virgin Mary a central place. They could hardly do otherwise. The newborn Christ is always in her care. Saint Luke tells us that the shepherds found "Mary and Joseph, and the infant lying in the manger" (Lk 2:16). Likewise, when the Magi arrived, "they saw the child with Mary his mother" (Mt 2:11). It is only within the context of her adoration that they – and we – adore him. She is the one who adores first and best.

She first adores him within her womb. She knows by the witness of the angel Gabriel that the child within her is the "Son of the Most High" (Lk 1:32). She knows by the inspired greeting of Elizabeth that she herself is the Mother of the Lord (cf. Lk 1:43). Thus for nine months she not only knows but *adores* the divine presence within her.

This helps us understand how we should respond to our reception of the Eucharist. In Holy Communion, the Son of God comes to dwell within us. When you receive the Host, you receive the one whom the angels adore eternally in heaven and whom Mary adored in her womb. This truth highlights the importance of making an act of thanksgiving after the reception of Holy Communion. We should value the time after receiving the Host as the most important of our day. He dwells in us, and we should adore his divine presence within us. We should also take some time after Mass to thank him for coming to us and to ask him for the graces we need to live his life. So, no watching the Communion lines after you receive and no racing out immediately afterwards. Adore the God who has come to dwell within you.

Interestingly, Giorgione's Adoration of the Shepherds doesn't show the infant Christ in the manger. Instead, he's lying on a white cloth on the ground and is propped up by a sheaf of wheat. That cloth reminds us of the *corporal*, the white cloth that the priest spreads on the altar and on which he places the Host that will become the Body of Christ. The wheat makes us think of bread and points us to the Bread of Life born of Mary. Mary kneels before her infant in adoration.

Mary's adoration of the newborn Christ corresponds to our adoration of the Eucharist. She looks upon the child and by faith knows that he is God, worthy of all adoration. We look upon the Sacred Host and by faith know that we are adoring both God and man.

But looking upon our Lord is only one part of Eucharistic adoration. We also want him to look upon us. Mary's face was the first that our Lord beheld with his human eyes. She looked upon him with "unveiled face" (2 Cor 3:18) and thus allowed herself to be seen entirely by him. May we do likewise.

May God bless your families this Christmas season.




#### **Inclement Weather Policy**




