

#### On The Way

The Adoration of the Angels

In our nativity scenes and Christmas cards (yes, I'm still wringing more reflections out of Christmas), we find not only the shepherds and the Magi adoring our Lord but also the *angels*. The biblical warrant for this is strong. It is the angels who announce our Lord's birth to the shepherds and then intone "Glory to God in the highest..." But to appreciate the meaning of their adoration, we need to understand their role in our fall and redemption.

It was an angel (of the fallen variety) that led us into sin. Scripture tells us that Lucifer and his minions fell out of *envy*. It is not clear what they envy. Some speculate that the demons envy our ability to procreate – to be cooperators with God in bringing about new person – a capacity the angels lack. That would explain why women and children are so often their targets. Some speculate that they envy us because God became one of us and not an angel.

In either case, God was associating himself with man in a way he did not with the angels, even though they are the higher creatures in the natural order. Thus, they envy that God favored us and they consequently resent that God would humble himself to be with us. Not surprisingly, it's into a similar envy and scorn of humility that Lucifer led Adam and Eve.

It is fitting that the same creatures that had a hand in our undoing should have a role in our redemption. Just as the fallen angels sneer at and reject God's humble association with us "hairless bipeds" (as C.S. Lewis's Screwtape calls us), so the good angels rejoice in that humility and thus share in it. Just as the demons resist the Incarnation, so do the angels minister to it. They are not in the least envious of the attention and special affection he has showered upon us. They know that it redounds to his glory and thus to theirs.

Just as the shepherds' adoration focused on God's likeness to us and the magi's focused on his poverty, so the angels' adoration focuses on his humility. In the place of their fallen comrades, the angels rejoice in God's prodigal display of humility in becoming one of us.

This joy in God's humility should also characterize our adoration of the Eucharist. He is just as present in the Host on the altar as he was in the manger in Bethlehem. The eternal Godhead united to our humble human nature is there. Remember, it is not just his divinity we adore in the Eucharist but also his humanity and, in that way, his humility. Further, in the Eucharist he humbles himself even more, by coming to us under the simple form of bread.

Finally, in adoration of the Eucharist we not only imitate the angels we are also united with them. The angels in heaven worship Jesus Christ as both God and man – in his glory and in his humility. The angels with us here in church worship him in the Eucharist also as God and man. We are with them in the act of adoring the divine humility. So, the next time you come to visit our Lord in the Eucharist, make sure to ask your guardian angel to assist you in your prayer – so that you can appreciate and adore the humble God as he does.



#### **Girl Scout Cookie Sales after Mass**


The St. James Girl Scouts will be selling Girl Scout Cookies before and after all Masses the weekends of February 5-6 and February 12-13.




