On The Way

The Adoration of Saint Joseph

We lose sight of Joseph at this time of year. He's the man in the shadows, not speaking a word but arranging everything for his wife and child. He adores the child Jesus in his own quiet manner. In so doing, he teaches different aspects about Eucharistic devotion.

First, stewardship. The God Joseph adores is also the child entrusted to his care. It's a curious combination and sets the terms of his stewardship. It's also an important corrective to our stewardship. Because in our pride we tend to think that those entrusted to our care ("subordinates," we call them) are below us, we can treat them rudely. Joseph, however, because he first adores Christ as God, cares for him with full awareness of the child's superiority and his own unworthiness.

This paradox is ours as well. In Holy Communion, Jesus Christ entrusts himself – body, blood, soul, and divinity – to our stewardship just as he did to Joseph's. Like Joseph, we are first to adore the one placed in our care. Our response after receiving the Host should be to adore his presence within us. Then we are to care for him and for his grace within us. Joseph was placed over our Lord to see that he would advance in wisdom and age and favor (cf. Lk 2:52). Similarly, we are stewards of Christ's eucharistic grace within us. We are to care for that grace so that it increases and grows, just as our Lord increased and grew under Joseph's care.

Second, petition. Given the above, it should be clear how Joseph's stewardship leads ineluctably to prayers of petition. Gazing upon the Christ child in the manger or perhaps asleep in his arms, Joseph has a keen awareness of his own insufficiency. He knows that he lacks what it takes to care for this child. Thus, he relies on prayer, so that he can be worthy of what God has already entrusted to him. He neither tries to depend on his own strength nor despairs in the lack of it. He relies on God's grace to fulfill the task of stewardship.

Saint John tells us that from Christ's fullness we have received, "grace in place of grace" (Jn 1:16). Point is, we need grace to respond to the grace entrusted to us. So, another response to our reception of Holy Communion is to pray for the grace to care for him within us. We know – and proclaim – that we are not worthy that he should enter under our roof. We should then ask for the grace to welcome and care for him as he deserves.

Third, Mary. Pope Saint Paul VI teaches that the Blessed Virgin Mary is intrinsic to Eucharistic worship. Not just helpful or even important but *intrinsic*. The Eucharist and Mary cannot be separated. Joseph was the first to live and know this truth. His relationship with our Lord is entirely by way of Mary. He is the father of Jesus only because he is first the husband of Mary. She is intrinsic to his adoration of Christ. He is the first to adore Jesus in the arms of Mary. He is also the first to adore Jesus in union with Mary.

So also, we should cultivate our devotion to Mary, so that she who conceived and bore the Son of God will also help us adore him properly.




