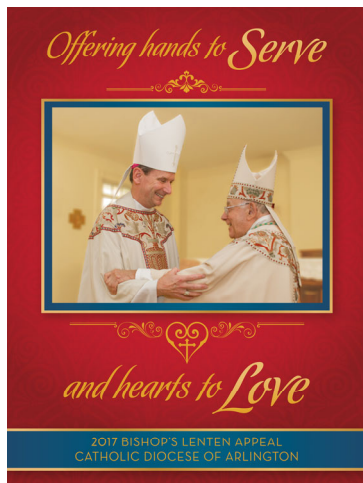

From Our Pastor



“Untie him and let him go” John 11:44

Today we hear once again of Lazarus’ resurrection, a clear foretelling of Christ’s own Resurrection – the ultimate sign of God’s power over death and His victory over sin. As Lazarus was bound in the tomb, so too can we be bound by our sins, hurts and fears which only separate us from the love of Christ. None of us are immune to these, priest or layperson alike. We all sin and are sinned against. When Pope Francis was asked to describe himself he said, “I am a sinner in need of redemption.”

It is easy to let sin overtake us, wrapping itself tighter around us until we are like Lazarus: bound by it completely. I am not talking about mortal sins, but the more insidious kinds which slowly make their way into our hearts. I think the greatest of these could be pride. This sense of self-righteousness can blind us to our own failings and make it impossible to forgive the failings of others. “I would never do such and such.” It can make us overlook that gossip we shared, the lie we told, the understanding we withheld. It can make us turn away from those in need. It can make us hold a grudge. It can ruin marriages, friendships and working relationships.

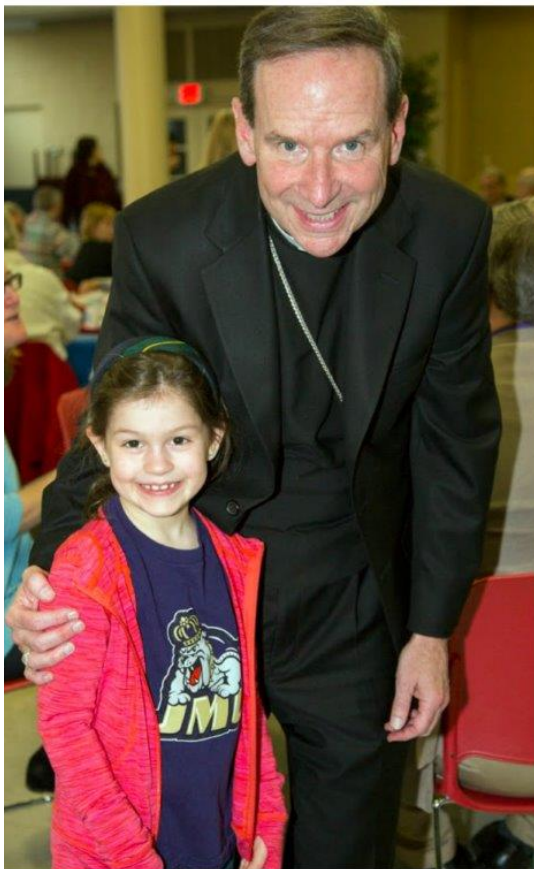
Christ calls to us as He did to Lazarus: COME OUT! “Take away the stone” that keeps you from a relationship with God, that divides our personal lives. *Unburden yourself* through Confession; make amends with someone you have hurt. Allow others to *free themselves* of sin by forgiving them.

It comes down to belief. “I am the resurrection and the life; do you believe this?” Who do you believe Jesus to be? Do you believe His teachings? Do you share His mercy? When He calls you to RISE will you hear His voice? Our path to the Resurrection continues. And the next time we read about a stone being rolled away, we will see and believe anew in God’s glory and great love for us. ~Fr. Posey

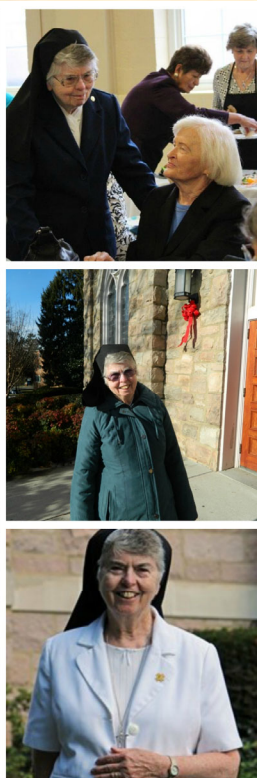
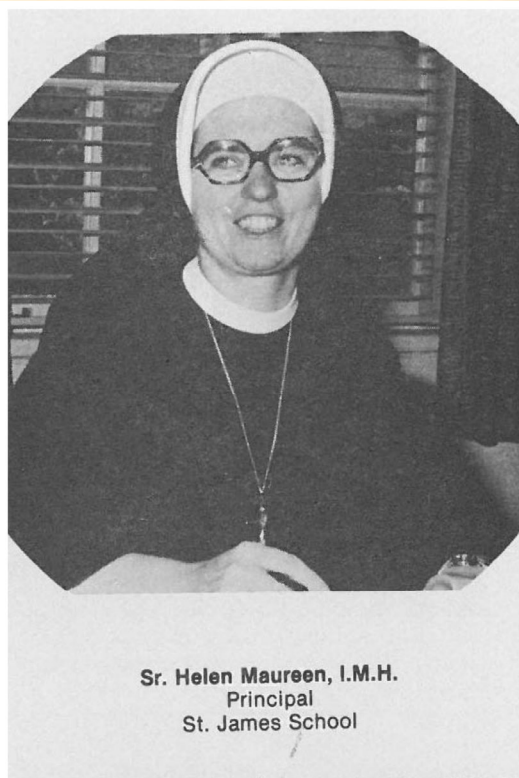

Parish Religious Education Program

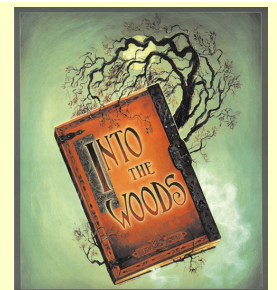

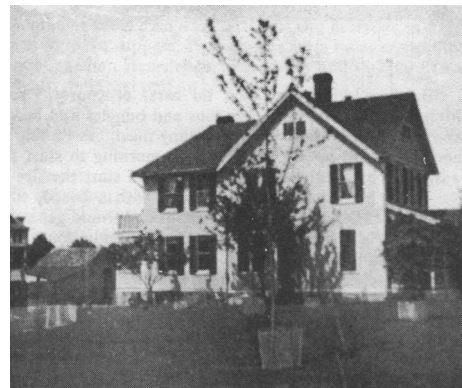
Villa Maria Academy Expands

When the number of boarders at Villa Maria Academy (in the original convent) increased to 40, Mother Clotildis who succeeded Mother Selesia as Superior in 1934, expanded the Academy to three separate locations. "Marianita" was opened for 1st and 2nd grade boarders in a white house that was located at the current playground behind the convent. Both Villa Maria and Marianita continued to overflow with students. Mother Clotildis negotiated the rental of the old Von Herbulis home (present site of Saint Joseph's Preschool on Spring Street) and it became "Villa Madonna" for 7th and 8th grade boarders. Mother Clotildis obtained temporary housing units from the War Department to provide additional dormitory space, and converted the old barn on the Von Herbulis property to a school for 3rd and 4th grade boarders.

Boarders continued to come to Villa Maria Academy and the Academy flourished. However, by 1952 Saint James School had grown so large that Villa Maria Academy needed to move. Mother Clotildis searched for property in Northern Virginia to relocate Villa Maria Academy, but settled on property in downstate Virginia. On July 2, 1952 Villa Maria Academy was moved to an estate in Lynchburg, Virginia where it continued as a boarding school under the IHM Sisters until its closing in 1983. Villa Maria Convent remained for the large number of IHM Sisters coming to St. James School during this time of growing need for teachers.

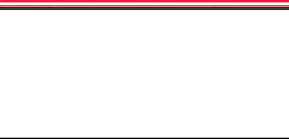
