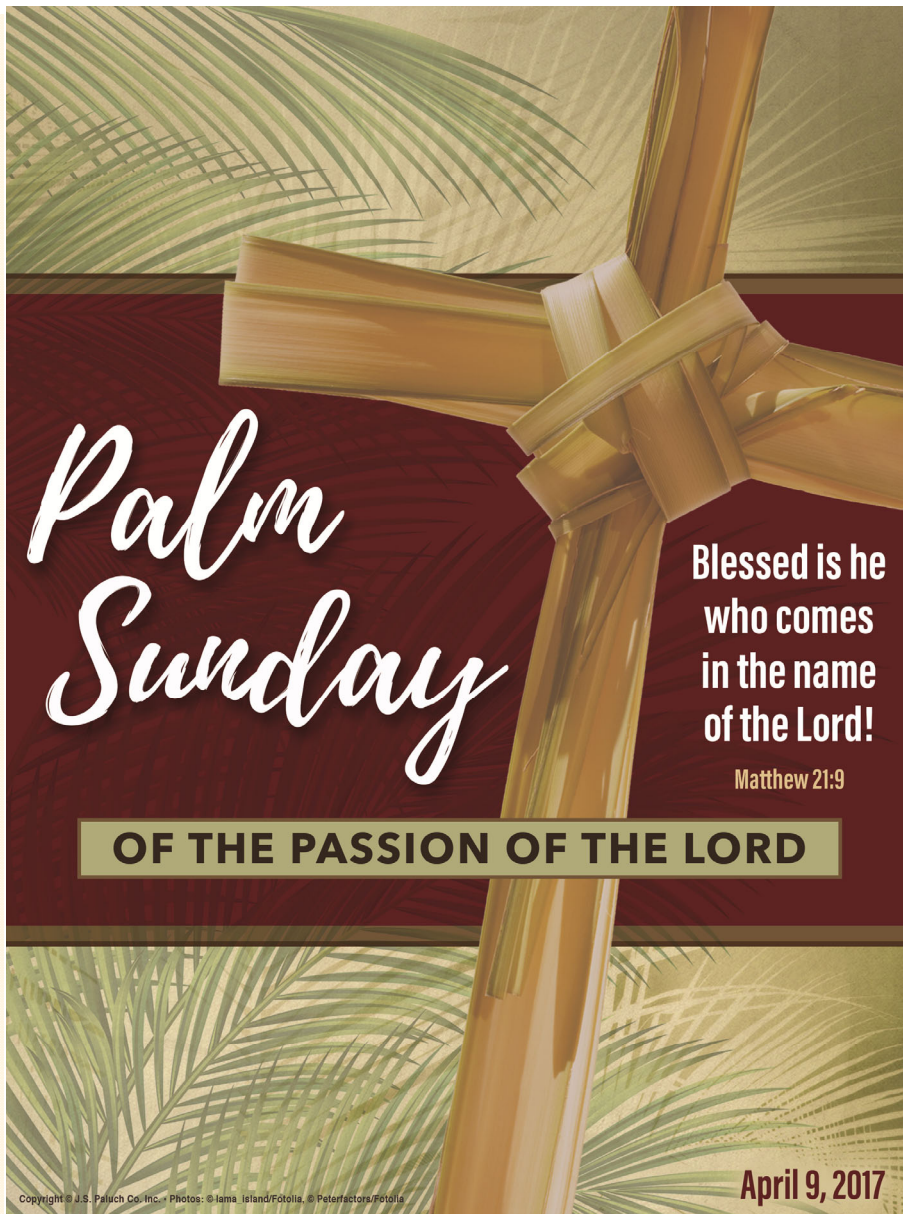

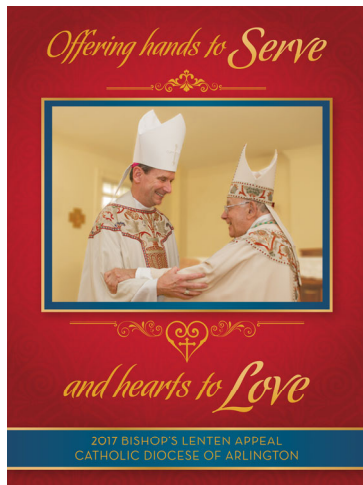

From Our Pastor



Even during Lent, I often quote Pope Francis, "Do not be people looking like you just came back from a funeral." Now, I begin this last week of Lent by echoing his sentiment that we must be people of tremendous faith, hope and joy:

Jesus enters Jerusalem. The crowd of disciples accompanies him in festive mood, their garments are stretched out before him, there is talk of the miracles he has accomplished, and loud praises are heard: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" (Lk 19:38).

Jesus has awakened great hopes, especially in the hearts of the simple, the humble, the poor, the forgotten, those who do not matter in the eyes of the world. He understands human sufferings, he has shown the face of God's mercy, and he has bent down to heal body and soul.

This is Jesus. This is his heart which looks to all of us, to our sicknesses, to our sins. The love of Jesus is great. And thus he enters Jerusalem, with this love, and looks at us. It is a beautiful scene, full of light - the light of the love of Jesus, the love of his heart - of joy, of celebration.

Christ is with us on this journey, from adulation to agony. But that is only a piece of the picture. Good Friday becomes "GOOD" Friday because it signals our redemption. Christ rose, defeated death and brought us salvation.

As you begin this Holy Week, do you bring others with you to this ultimate joy? Can they see Christ's efforts in you? Our reflection question this week invites us to remember Jesus in the Garden and pray for the strength and resolve to do God's will and accept our cup. Many of us carry heavy burdens and bitter cups, but even so, Pope Francis reminds us, "Do not let hope be stolen! The hope that Jesus gives us."

May you have a blessed Holy Week and Easter.

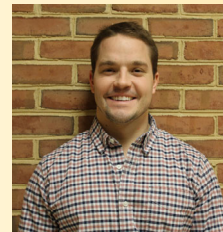

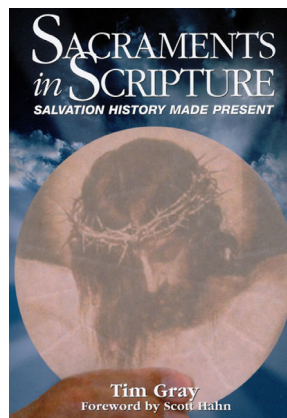

1944-1948 - BUILDING THE NEW SAINT JAMES SCHOOL

In 1944 Father Mullarkey put War Bonds he received as gifts for his 25th Jubilee of Ordination towards a new two-classroom school building. Despite the difficulty of obtaining building supplies during the post-war years, construction continued at a steady pace to build a new and larger St. James School. Two classrooms became four, and then ten; and the new school structure began to replace the original school at the same approximate site. The new St. James School was dedicated in 1948. The new building included ten classrooms, a library, cafeteria, auditorium (gym), clinic and office. It was believed that the beautiful new school would be sufficient to care for all foreseeable parish expansion for years to come.

The new 1944 school is the front wing of the current school facing Broad Street today. Today the classrooms are assigned to the 3rd-5th grades and include a recently redesigned Computer lab, newly established Robotics lab, up-to-date Science lab and school offices. The original auditorium (“old gym”) and stage were renovated during a mid-1990’s strategic school renovation and are now the library, and music and art classrooms. The construction of the Knecht Gym was included in this strategic plan.

Who was the architect for the new school buildings?

One long-time parishioner remembers the name Frank Martinelli. Mr. Martinelli and his family were members of St. James and he was a member of the American Institute of Architects from 1949 until his death in 1966. His son James, for a time the mayor of Vienna, Virginia, was his partner. The search continues for confirmation that Frank Martinelli designed the new school buildings.
