## From Our Seminarian



Previous summers found me retreating to the wilderness – away from busyness, cars, concrete, and noise. This summer in Falls Church I have been immersed in it! Yet, I still had adventures just as good as in the backwoods. Adventures in a way of life that, God willing, I will spend rest of my life doing: adventures greater than I ever thought, meeting and serving people I never thought I would, teaching and spreading the good news that our Lord loves us exuberantly. In a way, my time here was like that of the disciples' time with Christ, as we see in the Gospel: watching Christ (or in my case the priest's) preaching and healing in the hill country. The summer now comes to a close and I return to Mount Saint Mary's to continue my studies. The Lord has asked me to get in the boat and leave the shores of St. James to prepare to meet him on the other side.

Jesus takes his disciples on adventures. His invitation to discipleship is a call to leave everything to follow Him. As we see in Matthew's Gospel today, it is a call to stand up to the lies and fears of the world and get out of the boat and walk to Him. Imagine the quiet of the boat as Peter steps out. All the other disciples look at him in awe of His faith, or stupidity. Peter ventured forth into the unknown. My greatest adventure in my time at Saint James has been meeting our God in prayer: meeting him in a silence that is so foreign to the rest of my day. In that silence we encounter the wilderness of our own hearts. We step over the lies of the world only by Christ's command and let Him pull us up out of the water, believing in Him, who is truth.

At Saint James I encountered beauty, finding the manifestation of truth in the world. I saw the same thing in wilderness of Colorado and Ontario: God Himself being made present in the beauty of the world. The experience here was different because it was incarnate in His bride, the Church. As we worked together to espouse ourselves with Him, I was able to see how the parish works on our corporate holiness. The wilderness exists for the sake of the rest of the world, reminding us of how different life could be. The parish exists for the sake of the rest of the world for the same reason. The parish is the beacon of light to the world. It is Christ made incarnate in the wilderness of Falls Church by His people, every one that sits in the pews. I am very grateful for all those I have met and how they have shown me Christ. All those who taught me how to navigate this wilderness and who live in it spreading Christ's message. I sincerely appreciate the gift that I have been given in witnessing the work of the parish. I hope to pass on to others all that I have experienced here. I am grateful for the love shown me here in your home and hope that in my eventual service to be able to magnify that same love.

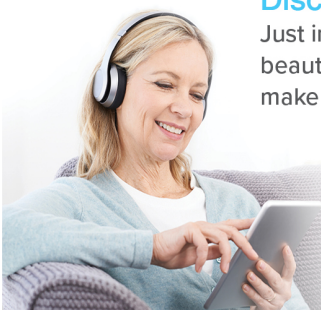

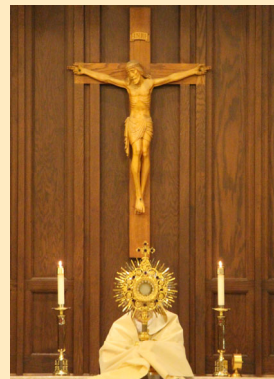

## 1956 - ST. JOSEPH PRESCHOOL & THE SPANISH SISTERS

The statue of St. Joseph standing on Spring Street, midway between Park Avenue and Fulton, marks the home of St. Joseph's Preschool and Nursery, a unique part of St. James parish since the school's beginnings in 1958.

Three sisters of the Congregation of the Servants of St. Joseph came to the United States in 1956 to serve the community as well as learn the language. First to arrive were Mother Superior Ascension Manzana, Sister Virginia Pozo, and Sister Olga Peralta. They purchased the property on Spring Street from the Diocese of Richmond and began the process of applying for the license for a school. They were joined by Sister Prudentia Gonzalo and Sister Augustina Temprano. That first year was hard but help came from Father Heller, pastor of St. James, as well as unexpected support from parishioners. Construction delays resulted in a first class of only three students.

Once opened and operating, the school grew and flourished. By 1968, the school that had been built for 40 was overcrowded. There was an increasing number of children from other countries, in particular from Cuba, during a time of political disturbance. A new school was built, and is still in use, serving a student body of 80.

During succeeding years, Sister Ived and Sister Celia joined the community, who lived in a house provided by Father Tuck Grinnell at St. Anthony Church near Baileys Crossroads. Children of those early students have attended, carrying on a family tradition.



In February of 2005, at a school meeting attended by both parents and Sisters, the Sisters announced that the school would be closing, and the Sisters going to other missions in Spain and Latin America. After their immediate shock and dismay, school parents were determined to purchase the school and keep it going. And going it is, with a staff of lay teachers and full enrollment.

Sister Augustina is the only member of the community still living in the Falls Church area, in Culmore. She works at Hope of Northern Virginia, just down Park Avenue from St. James. Hope is an organization providing caring and unconditional support to women with crisis pregnancies. Sister Augustina looks back on her years in Falls Church as a blessing. "God gives us the grace and the interest to work. This is my charisma."
