## From Our Pastor

---



When I was a child, we had this large Santa lawn ornament; at least it was large to my younger self. Every December out he came to grace our front yard. I loved Santa. Santa didn't belong outside in the cold; he belonged with me in the warm house! So every year without fail I dragged that Santa inside. I wanted him nearby. Even though I knew it wasn't the real Santa, just having him in the house made me happy and longing for Christmas Day.

Wouldn't it be great to have that same feeling about Jesus? We set up our nativity scenes, carefully placing the wise men along the "road" to Bethlehem; keeping the infant Jesus safe, but out of the crib until Christmas morning. Shouldn't we desire to bring Christ into our homes too? Shouldn't we get that same excitement knowing that our Savior will be born soon?

Tomorrow we celebrate Christmas. For many it will be a time of family gatherings, presents and joy. For some it may be a day spent in the hospital caring for a loved one; or the gatherings may not bring great anticipation but worry and anxiety. Yet, whether we are with a crowd or alone, Christ is with us. In our first reading today, our Lord tells David that he does not reside just in a building. "I have been with you wherever you went." (2 Samuel 7:9) Incarnate, Jesus moves beyond the crib into our community. Will you follow him from the crèche to our culture at large?

I still have that Santa. He's in my room now as I write this. This Christmas let us bring Christ into our hearts. Let Him live in the light of our lives. Keeping Him close will bring you more happiness, more peace, and yes, more joy than any box beneath the tree ... or any Santa on a lawn.

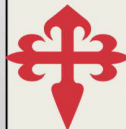

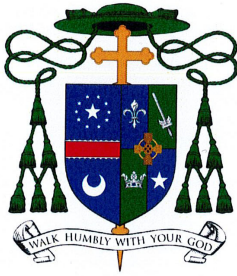

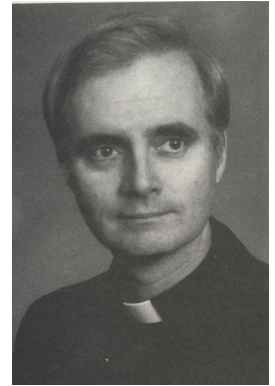

## 1990-1992 - MONSIGNOR REINECKE, EIGHTH PASTOR

Msgr. William T. Reinecke was named the eighth pastor of St. James in 1990. At the same time, he held the diocesan offices of Chancellor and Vicar General. He served St. James until his passing in 1992.



1892–2017

Within months of his arrival at St. James, Msgr. Reinecke began preparations for our 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Letters went to the IHM Mother General, historian Gerald Fogarty, S.J., long-time parishioners, the company that created the stained glass windows and to the Apostolic Nuncio Agostino Cacciavillan who accepted the invitation to celebrate the anniversary Mass on the afternoon of April 26. In addition to the archbishop and Arlington Bishop Thomas Keating, many current and assigned priests from the diocese concelebrated, including Father William Schopps and Father Steve Leva. A dinner at the Knights of Columbus, following the Mass of Thanksgiving, featured reminiscences of long-time parishioners about early life at St. James. Several of those talks are in our archives and were a great resource in compiling these stories.

A parish family donated the sanctuary lamp above the tabernacle. Director of Music Ministry and organist Dan Day tells this story about the organ:

The formation of a traditional adult choir, to complement the dedicated contemporary choir, was under consideration. The parish organist had recently accepted a new position at a large parish north of Baltimore. Monsignor Reinecke sought to hire a new organist committed to building a traditional choir as well as supporting active sung participation in the Masses accompanied by organ. Parishioners were invited to join a new adult choir and responded generously to this initiative in the fall of 1990.

Members of St. James' community had embraced the call of Vatican II to engage more fully in the ministries of the church including sung participation in the liturgy. A modest pipe organ had been installed in 1965 just as the renewal of the liturgy began to be implemented. In the early 1990s, it became clear that the revisions of the liturgy and enhanced sung participation in worship called for a larger organ better able to support the congregational singing integral to the revised rites as well as the traditional devotions of the Church.

Providentially, in 1991, a member of the choir generously donated the funds to commission the building of a new organ in memory of a deceased family member. The intent was to have a new organ built and installed during the spring of 1992 to celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the parish. Specifications for the organ were developed and bids sought. Ultimately, Charles E. Kegg of Uniontown, Ohio, submitted the winning design and bid. Due to a delay in the construction of the organ pipes, the organ was not able to be installed in time for the celebration of the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Mass. Yet installation had begun and was completed in late May 1992. Parishioners including children from St. James school were invited to presentations on the process of building and installing a pipe organ while it was in process.

**The dedication plaque on the organ reads:**

St. James Centenary Organ  
dedicated with love to the memory of  
Rose Joan Cherski DeSotelo  
Born Aug. 1921 Died Oct. 1984  
Donated by the  
Seoane and Sotelo Families

This fine instrument has served the community well for over 25 years now and will hopefully enhance the liturgical participation of our parish family well into the 21<sup>st</sup> century. May we remember in prayer those who donated this instrument, their family and all members of St. James Music Ministry who now participate in the heavenly liturgy.

St. James associate pastor Father William Schopps was named administrator of the parish after the death of Monsignor Reinecke until the appointment of Monsignor Roy Cosby in 1993. During his time at St. James, Father Schopps used his computer expertise to update our parish records, moving from paper to electronic files.
