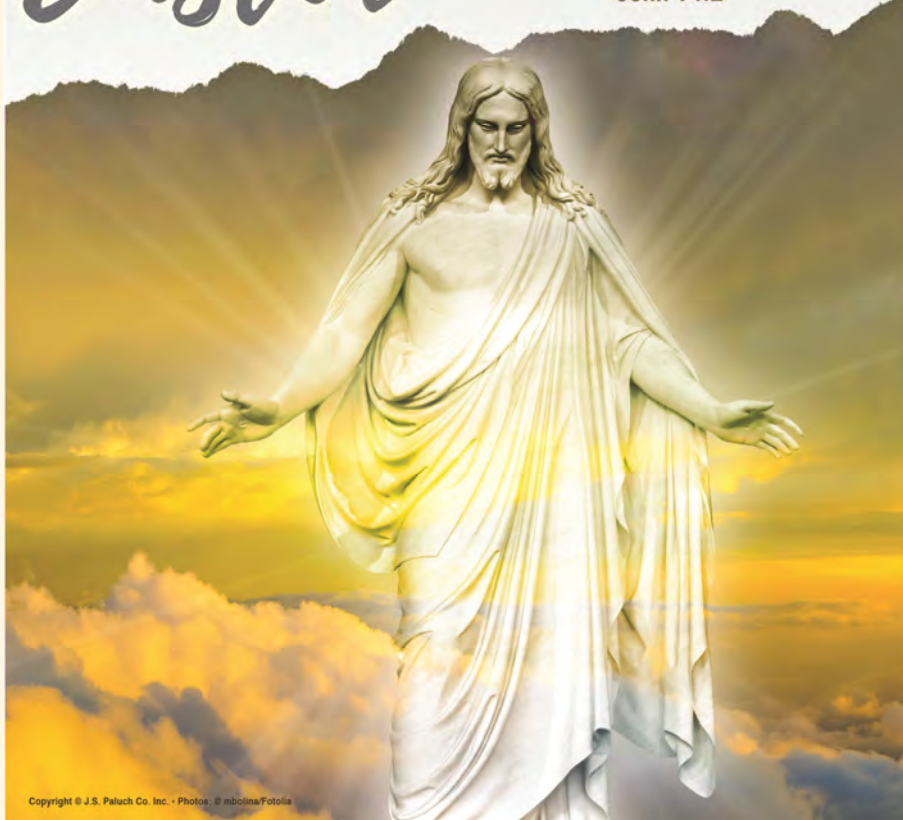

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our diocesan priests dedicate their lives to serve and guide us on our life-long journey of faith. They have administered the sacraments, counseled, encouraged and prayed for us and our families. And just like many of us, they desire a suitable place to live once they reach retirement.

Currently there are 182 diocesan priests faithfully serving Jesus Christ and you, the people who form our diocesan Church. Of these, 21 priests are retired, and over the next ten years 20 additional priests will reach retirement age.

Next weekend, May 20 and 21, at all Masses, the annual second collection for retired priests will take place in all parishes in our diocese.

The funds from this annual collection will assist several special needs including the ongoing operational expenses of the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*, a beautiful and restful home that includes common areas and private suites for up to 15 priests. Since his retirement, Bishop Emeritus Paul Loverde has called this retirement villa his home. This special collection also will provide funds for post-retirement health care, nursing home care, and the priests' pension fund.

I ask you to be as generous as possible, so that our priests, who served us so faithfully, may be fittingly cared for in their retirement years.

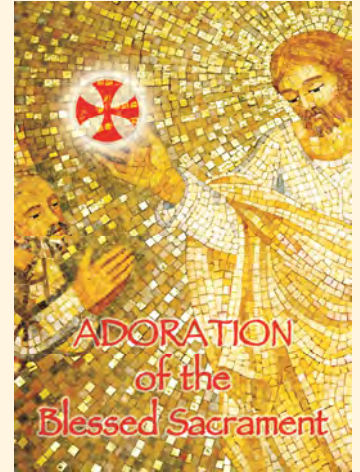

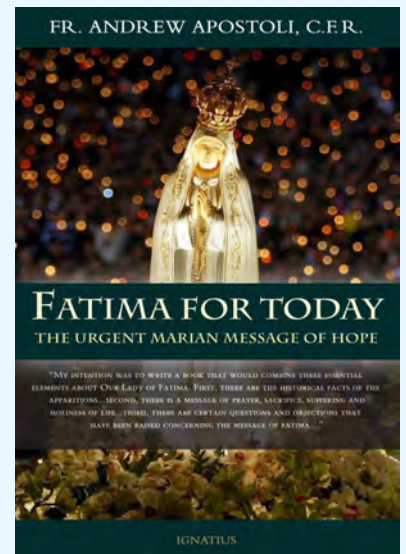

## 1949 - A PERMANENT KINDERGATEN IS ESTABLISHED IN THE SCHOOL

In 1949 the first Kindergarten class began in St. James School. The Kindergarten was first located in the white house behind the convent that was once occupied by Villa Maria Academy. Later Kindergarten classes were held in the Primary wing of the school when it was completed in 1955.

MRS. MARY CLARKE (KINDERGARTEN) AND MRS. MARY DELANEY (FIRST GRADE), RETIRED TEACHERS FOR WHOM THE CLARKE-DELANEY TEACHER FUND IS NAMED.



Mrs. Mary Jessel Clarke is most remembered as one of St. James School's beloved Kindergarten teachers (1970-2009). After retiring from teaching, Mrs. Clarke has stayed at St. James as a counselor in the Extended Day program to this day. Before teaching, Mrs. Clarke was a St. James School student (Class of 1952) and, together with her husband, Jim, were school parents while their sons were in attendance at St. James.

MRS. MARY JESSEL CLARKE

Mary Jessel Clarke and life-long parishioner, **Jeanne McCauley Trott**, were both in the St. James Class of 1952. In 1944 Mary and Jeanne began 1<sup>st</sup> grade in the original 1905 three-classroom school. The

next year the new two-classroom building, built from gifts Father Mullarkey received on his Silver Jubilee, was completed and Mary and Jeanne attended 2<sup>nd</sup> grade in one of these new classrooms. Each following year, Mary and Jeanne attended school in a new classroom as construction continued of the current school building. This large 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation class of 72 students was the last class to go through St. James School attending each grade together in a single classroom. This was also the last class to graduate that was not required to wear a school uniform.
