Ministry Highlight – Legion of Mary

As we continue our parish self-study, this week's history article gives us a closer look at the Legion of Mary, which offers prayers and good works throughout our community. ~Fr. Posey

A worldwide organization of lay Catholic men and women, the Legion of Mary aims to glorify and grow closer to God through prayer, spiritual direction, and works involving evangelization and spiritual formation.

The Legion at St. James invites all those at least 18 years old who are interested in serving Mary and the Church to join our meeting each Tuesday from 7:30– 9:00pm at the House of Ministries, 913 Park Avenue (next to the Rectory). Here we share prayers, spiritual readings, recitation of the Rosary, and reports regarding our assigned work activity of the past week.

One of our works, for example, is to bring the Pilgrim Virgin Statue (Our Lady of Fatima) to parishioner homes upon request. The family hosting the statue for one week and Legion members bringing it recite together the Rosary and prayers of welcome. The host family is encouraged to recite the Rosary daily. Legion members return at the week's end and recite farewell prayers with the family.

Legion of Mary members also visit fellow parishioners in their homes and retirement communities, attend retreats and pilgrimages, and celebrate Marian feast days.

A 90-day probationary period enables newcomers to discern their compatibility for this ministry. The Legion at St. James also offers auxiliary membership involving daily recitation of the Rosary, the Magnificat, and other prayers.

Please do not leave items outside on the sidewalk when the doors are locked. We have extended hours and welcome your donations during the hours we are available.

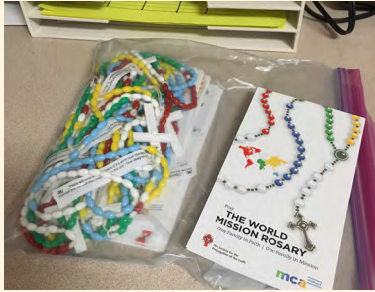

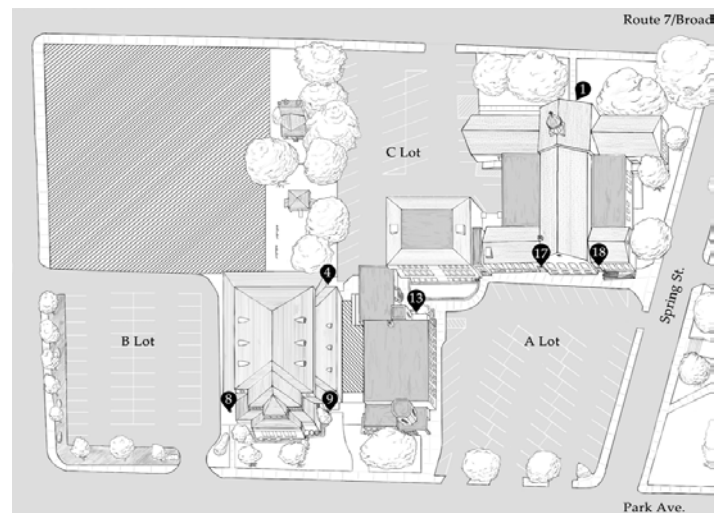

Join us for a prayer service led by Fr. Posey at our cemetery on Saturday, November 4 at 10:00am. Take time to honor those who came before us building a community of faith and fellowship. A guided tour led by parishioner Jeanne Trott will follow the service. Walk on the site of our first parish church, and look for the graves of those who gave the land for its building. Children are welcome! Help us find special symbols and markings as we learn more about our history. The cemetery is located at the intersection of S. West Street and Fowler Street, less than a mile from church. Parking is available on Fowler Street and along the cemetery on S. West Street.

ST. JAMES CEMETERY (Part I)

In November every year, the whole Church lifts up those who have gone before us – saints whose names mark the calendar and all those just ones whose souls are in the hand of God. The names of many are carved on the headstones in our cemetery at South West and Fowler Streets.

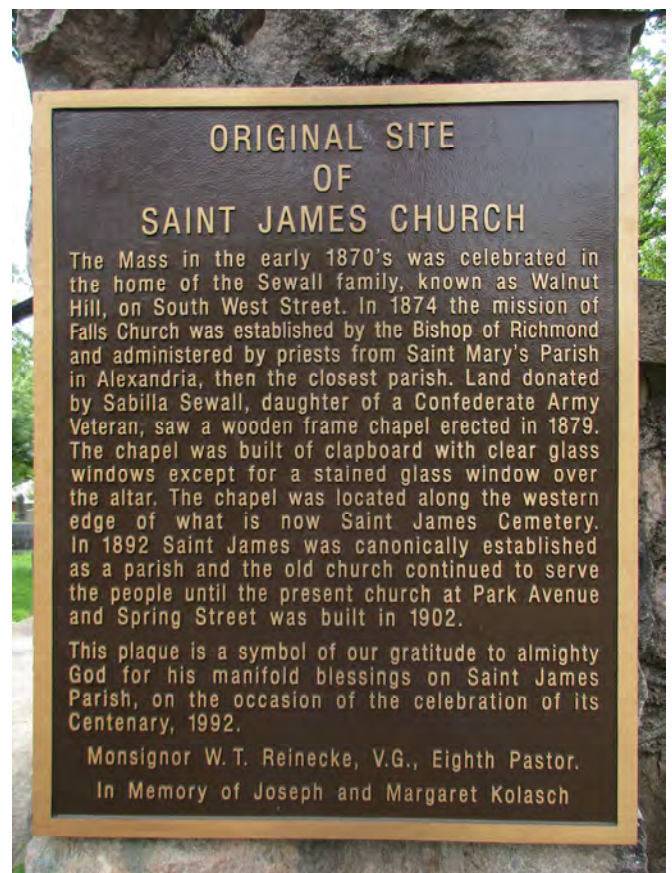
A few steps off the main walkway, a weathered granite block marks the graves of Louis and Sarah Sewall and their daughter Louisa. Sarah died in 1890. A short distance away, Jane Sybilla Sewall, another daughter who died unmarried in her 93rd year, was buried in 1927. Their bones lie in the field the Sewall family donated for the building of a frame chapel in 1873 to house the church that had been meeting on Sundays in their home on West Street. One hundred twenty-five years later, the Sewall family rests in the midst of Catholics empowered by the Spirit who built St. James into the community of faith it is in 2017.

The cemetery and the gravestones of the people who rest here tell part of the story of who we are as a parish. Many who formed the parish in the early days are identified as immigrants – born in County Wexford; born in Donegal, a child's marker written in mosaic in Italian – people who had left their homes and countries to put down roots in a new land. People are still coming from other lands to enrich us with their fortitude and courage. Witness gravestones of Vietnamese, Latin American, Chinese. Here are some others who help tell our parish story:

- Sister Serapia, of the Perpetual Adoration order which began our school, died during the flu epidemic in 1919. Though unconfirmed, it is likely that the epidemic prevented the return of her body to Louisiana for burial.
- Father Mullarkey was pastor here from 1931 to 1953, overseeing the enlargement of the church and school. A Celtic cross marks his grave. He is not the only priest buried here.
- Barbara Patterson's funeral in 1899 was delayed a week by a blizzard. Her descendants were among the last families to live in the House of Ministries before it became parish offices.
- Members of the military from the Civil War onward, young people and babies, an architect and a labor leader, and just plain folks rest here.
- Margaret I. Burke (d. 1866 at age 19) and Bennet Carroll (1798-1868) were buried in this land even before the frame church was built here in 1873.
