Meet Fr. Oetjen

Fr. Steven Oetjen (pronounced ae-jen) is one of the newest priests of our diocese. He was ordained a priest by Bishop Burbidge on June 10, and St. James is his first assignment as a parochial vicar. A native of Northern Virginia, he attended St. Mary's Catholic School in Alexandria and Thomas Jefferson High School for Science and Technology. He studied engineering at Carnegie Mellon and spent time at the Newman Center, where he found friends living joyful, virtuous lives, and an inspirational example in the priests of the Congregation of the Oratory of St. Philip Neri. Eucharistic Adoration gave him great solace. Eventually, he discerned a call to the priesthood and entered the seminary after completing his undergraduate degree.



He studied for two years at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary before transferring to the Pontifical North American College in Rome at Bishop Loverde's request. During his years as a seminarian, he experienced a variety of parish settings by serving at St. Catherine of Siena, St Mary of Sorrows, St. Timothy, and Sacred Heart in Winchester. Now at St. James, Fr. Oetjen leads our youth ministry with a team of parishioners and provides the sacraments to homebound parishioners and those who live at Chesterbrook. He also supports our emerging young adult community, the scouting ministries, CYO, the Legion of Mary and our Pro-Life Group.

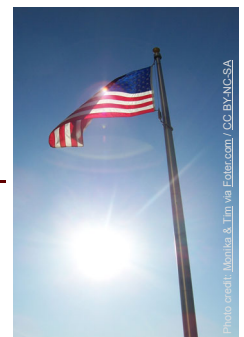

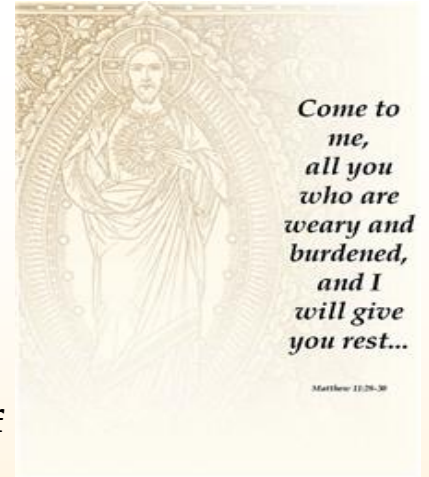

Caring for Kids Drive – September 16 & 17

Seven Corners Children's Center is a private, non-profit organization started in 1971 by a local group of religious leaders. SCCC partners with Fairfax County to provide day care and family support services to the working poor in a multi-cultural setting.

Every year, 70 at risk children ages 2-5 are given nurturing care and early childhood education that prepares them for kindergarten. In addition they are provided with medical, hearing, dental, speech and vision screenings as needed to ensure that they are ready to learn. Both parents work and pay for these services on a sliding scale.



Each year through our Caring for Kids drive, St. James parishioners have supplemented SCCC funds to help them carry out their mission to these children. This year, one of their goals is to upgrade the toddler playground. Social Outreach Committee members will be collecting donations after masses the weekend of September 16 and 17. We ask for your generous financial response to help them meet this year's needs.

MSGR. PAUL V. HELLER YEARS:
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF BISHOP O'CONNELL HIGH SCHOOL
AND THE DIOCESE OF ARLINGTON

Bishop O'Connell High School:

With the post-World War II expansion of Arlington County came the need for a parochial high school



to serve the needs of families in Northern Virginia. Six parishes, St. James, St. Agnes, St. Ann, St. Charles, St. John and St. Thomas More, purchased a twenty-acre tract of land in 1949. The school was established under the Diocese of Richmond, the only Catholic diocese in the state of Virginia at the time. When Father Heller became pastor of St. James Parish in 1953, he was instrumental in supporting a fund raising drive to build the new high school. The successful drive resulted in a ground breaking ceremony on March 27, 1956. The school was named in honor of an outstanding educator and seventh Bishop of Richmond, Most Rev. Denis J. O'Connell. Bishop O'Connell High School opened its doors September 9, 1957 and graduated its first class in 1961. Father Heller served a lengthy time on the Board of Governors of the school. Bishop O'Connell High School came under the direction of the Diocese of Arlington when it was established in 1974.

Diocese of Arlington: In 1972 priests of the Alexandria and Arlington Deaneries requested Bishop John J. Russell, the 10th Bishop of the Diocese of Richmond, to initiate the process toward the establishment of a new diocese in their part of the Commonwealth. On August 13, 1974, Bishop Thomas J. Welsh, auxiliary of Philadelphia and rector of St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Overbrook, Pennsylvania, was installed in St. Thomas More Church as the first Bishop of Arlington. St. Thomas More Church was elevated to become the new diocesan cathedral. The new diocese began with more than 136,000 Catholics, 60 diocesan and 33 religious priests, 49 parishes and 7 missions.



Saint Thomas More became the patron saint for the Diocese of Arlington. He is also the patron saint for politicians, statesmen, lawyers and widowers. His feast day is on June 22. Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton is the secondary patron of the Diocese of Arlington. She is also the patron of Catholic schools. Her feast day is on January 4.
