## From Our Pastor

---



*I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me...*

I was in a store recently where I overheard a salesperson reply to a customer's query, "I'm only a part-time employee, I don't know much about this area of the store." Since the employee wasn't full time, he lacked complete knowledge of the store's inventory.

In today's Gospel, we are reminded that Jesus is "all in" as our leader, savior, and shepherd. Jesus, like the shepherds of his day, protects and cares for his flock. We are all familiar with the images of a silhouette of the Lord caressing a lamb gently and lovingly in his arms. We take comfort in this image because we all want to be that lamb, cared for and embraced by our loving Savior. This week keep that image of our Lord and the lamb in your thoughts as you go about your day-to-day life. Take solace in the knowledge that you indeed are always protected and embraced by our Shepherd.

Keep in mind, however, that the Lord's embrace doesn't take away the roughness of the terrain or the mountains that we need to climb in our life. It reminds us that we do not make the journey or climb alone. Just as he walked with his disciples on the road to Emmaus, Jesus walks with us to encourage and strengthen us. Unlike a part-time employee, Jesus knows his flock.

We also need to remember that being embraced by the Good Shepherd doesn't mean that we will never experience challenges or setbacks in our lives. We only need to reflect upon the disciples to see how denial and doubt can afflict us. Jesus himself told Peter that he too would drink of the cup of suffering. But if we remain with the shepherd and allow him to comfort us, if we stay in the fold of the shepherd, we will find peace. Pope Francis said, "The flock, which is all of us, has as a home a fold that gives refuge, where the sheep abide and rest after the fatigue of the journey."

Take time this week in the midst of your own rough terrains, or what feels like insurmountable mountains, and just put yourself in the loving, peaceful embrace of Jesus to rest, take comfort and begin the journey again.

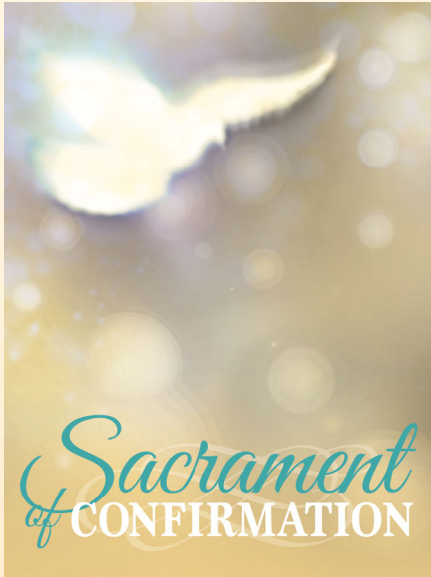

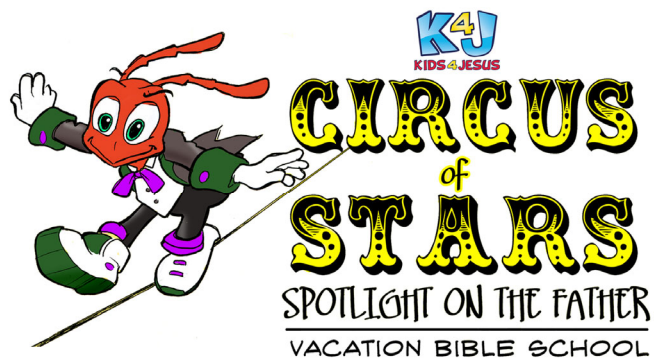
### Rejoice and Be Glad: On the call to holiness in today's world
