From Our Pastor



Our readings today begin on a rather depressing note: Job talks of the drudgery of his life, bereft of hope or happiness. At some juncture, we can all relate to his feelings; in our lives there are too many bills to pay, too much stress at work or at home, too much physical or emotional pain. We can easily see ourselves in Job's despair – what is the point to all our fruitless attempts?

We find the point in the words of the Psalmist who reminds us that our Lord is indeed kind and compassionate: "He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. He tells the number of the stars; he calls each by name." (Ps 147: 3-4) God knows the burdens we carry, the 'demons' which need to be exorcised, the hearts which need to be mended. He does not say that our lives will be without pain. He does not say that we will not struggle against the "wicked." But the Psalmist does say that God will not abandon us. Mark's Gospel reinforces this by revealing a glimpse of Jesus' everyday ministry. Jesus heals mind, body and soul, carrying our burdens ultimately on a cross. "For this purpose have I come." (Mk 1:38)

Our Bishop's Lenten Appeal officially begins next weekend. Through this endeavor, we become Christ's hands and feet amidst our community – here and beyond our parish. We can bind the "wounds" of poverty and hunger; we can come to know each other "by name" in service; we can preach the Gospel as Paul and assist our men and women discerning lives of sacrifice "so as to win over as many as possible." Each year our parishioners are extremely generous. On behalf of Bishop Burbidge, I ask you once again to prayerfully consider supporting the diocese's efforts to live our faith in gratitude. Our parish goal is \$295,000. I am grateful for your past generosity and thank you in advance for your commitment to the BLA this year.

Pro-Life Committee Prepares for Lenten 40 Days for Life Campaign to Start on February 14

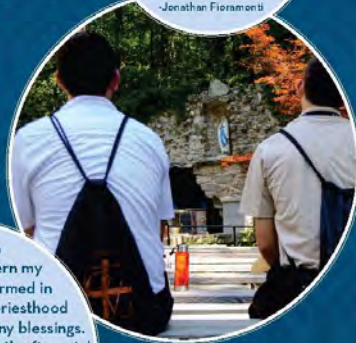
