## From Our Pastor



*I turn to you, Lord, in time of trouble,  
and you fill me with the joy of salvation.*  
– Psalm 32

Ash Wednesday reminds us of our humanity and connection to God. Lent, unlike Advent, another season of waiting, is too often seen as a simply time of deprivation: “I have to give something

up.” And yes it is a time when we sacrifice things or habits; but, doing so actually takes us on a path towards gain. A healthier life style. A kinder heart. A richer spiritual life.

It is also the perfect time to reflect on aspects of our daily lives which may be a barrier to these. Where in the fabric of our life are the snags?

To this end, I invite you to join me in prayer and devotion to the image of Mary, Undoer of Knots. Hundreds of years ago this painting was commissioned to honor Mary’s intervention in a marital crisis. During a visit to his local Jesuit, a husband brought the ribbon which was used during his wedding ceremony to bind the couple’s arms thereby symbolically sealing their unbreakable marital bond. The priest held the very old ribbon up to a painting of Mary and as he was untying the knots, the ribbon became dazzling white. In the painting you can see that Our Lady helps us untie those “knots” which burden our hearts and hinder our souls’ journey to God.

Each week we will reflect on this beautiful Lenten theme, asking Mary to intercede on our behalf. Please take a prayer card and bracelet from the baskets at the entrances to accompany you on this spiritual journey.

I pray this Lent your hearts are open to God’s mercy. God bless.

- The Gabriel Project and Project Rachel Offices work to provide pregnancy assistance, post-abortion spiritual healing and coordinates with the Respect Life Office to restore dignity for all human life.
- Gabriel Project helps pregnant women with long or short-term needs by offering assistance at the parish level. It involves a network of churches, crisis pregnancy centers and other agencies working together to assist the mother with physical, material, spiritual, and emotional support.
- Project Rachel is a post-abortive healing ministry open to mothers, fathers, grandparents, siblings or anyone who seeks healing after abortion. This ministry seeks to reach out with the mercy and love of Christ and to help be at peace with oneself and God.
- Resources are available for post-abortive women such as a confidential phone line, availability of a priest for spiritual guidance, professional counseling, as well as retreats for women and men who are in need of healing.
- The Respect Life Office offers resources and a collection of ways to help respect life, both in prayer and in action. This office provides educational materials to keep parishioners informed of the current issues in regards to all human life from the moment of conception until natural death.



## 2017 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Gabriel Project provided support to 255 mothers with prenatal care and/or monetary and medical assistance.
- 52 healthy babies were born to Gabriel Project Mothers.
- Project Rachel ministered to 150 post-abortive women who sought true healing through the mercy and love of Christ.
