From Our Pastor



"Who are my mother and my brothers?"

Our readings today focus on relationships. The "fall of man" reference from Genesis relates the first break in our relationship with God our Father and indeed with each other. Further reading into the chapter shows the strain placed on the relationship between husband and wife as well as on our connection to the earth. The equilibrium has been shaken.

Christ becomes a vehicle for a new beginning, a new genesis between God and humanity. He repairs that bond, broken by sin, healed by sacrifice and strengthened by the Holy Spirit. We are all God's children, all possessing the "same spirit of faith," as Paul relates. We are linked by more than familial ties. "Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother." Jesus turns the idea of family on its head. In a time where tribal loyalties were supreme, this was a radical statement; you might actually think Jesus was "out of his mind." For if everyone is my brother or sister, my father or mother then my duty to them is just as strong as to those in my nuclear family. How could I possibly care for or about someone who is not my kin? How could I possibly want to shoulder that burden?

It is not always easy; sometimes our spiritual family may not act as we want, look how we want, or talk how we want. Sometimes they may even do things that actively confuse, anger or even hurt us. Christ dares us to see past all that in a radical call to discipleship. Answer Christ when he calls - show kindness to the suffering - show patience to the trying - show mercy to the transgressor. It doesn't have to be a grand gesture; as Saint Mother Teresa has said, even the smallest stone tossed into the river causes ripples. Be that ripple effect.

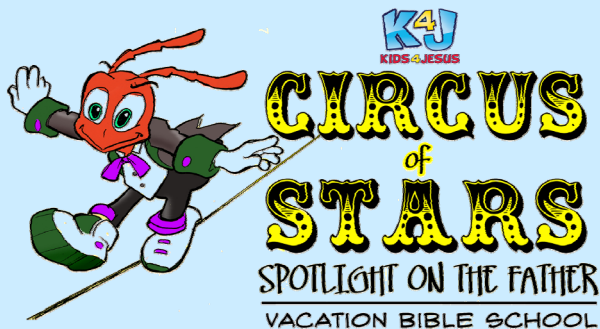
