From Our Pastor



“We walk by faith, not by sight...”

With all the recent storms, losing power was inevitable. I was in my office late one evening when a storm left me fumbling around the room. I almost said, “Alexa, find the door.” Now you would think that it would be easy for me to navigate a place where I have spent many hours over the last 12 years. But the dark was disorienting; the chair that I was sure was a few feet to my right met my foot squarely, and rather painfully. After a few embarrassing seconds I reminded myself that I knew where I was going; I knew the path upstairs. Light can make us take our surroundings for granted. We can easily see the things which can be our pitfalls.

Faith demands that we abandon the need for physical proof. Two thousand years after Christ talked of mustard seeds and vines, we believe not because we saw Jesus Himself, but because we see Him in the world around us and in those with whom we share it. This sight asks us to look beyond the shadows, to go beyond the superficial and see the divine. Just as it's not always easy to move in the dark, faith is not always simple. Faith also demands trust, to believe even when there is no light to be seen. In times of great distress we need to remember that faith is our guide. It may not lead to a perfect resolution: loved ones pass, illness attacks, disappointment occurs; but it does lead to grace and the strength to face the darkness and walk.

Today we honor our fathers, living and deceased, and those who are like fathers to others. Beyond the new tie or special dinner, let us remember all the ways they mirror the love of our heavenly Father. Take today to tell them you love them. It would be naïve and perhaps even hurtful to assume that every father-child relationship is perfect; just as it would be with moms. To those whose relationship is fractured, absent or strained, I ask you to try to reach out, and if this is impossible I ask that you accept the grace found here. Break the cycle and share your love with others. God bless.

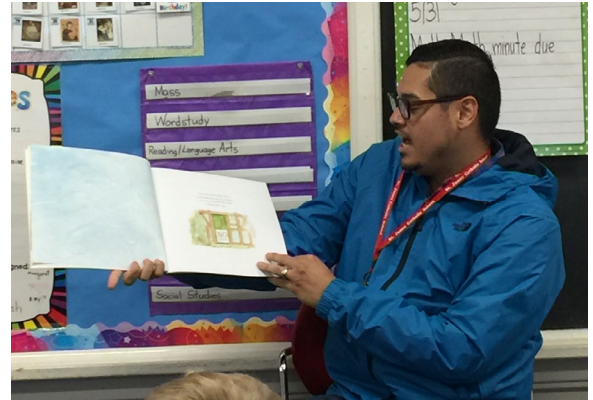

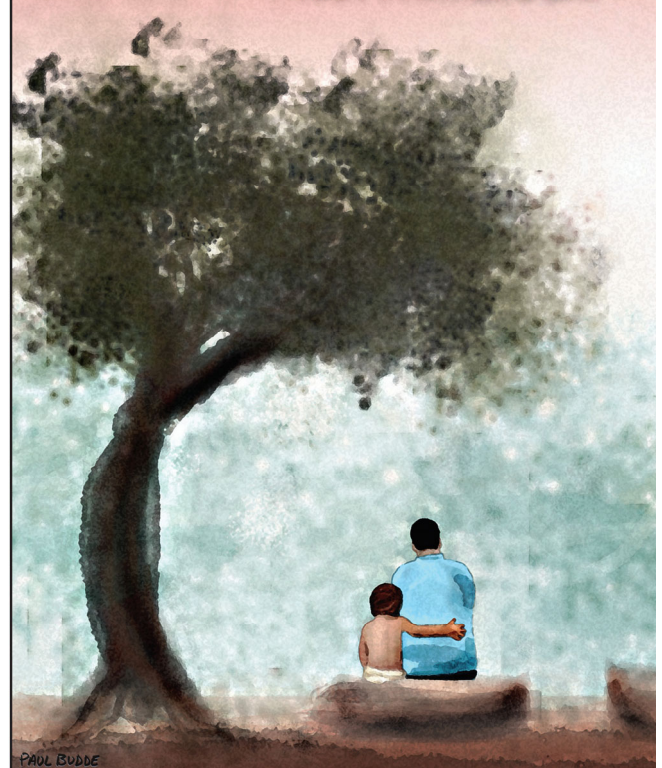

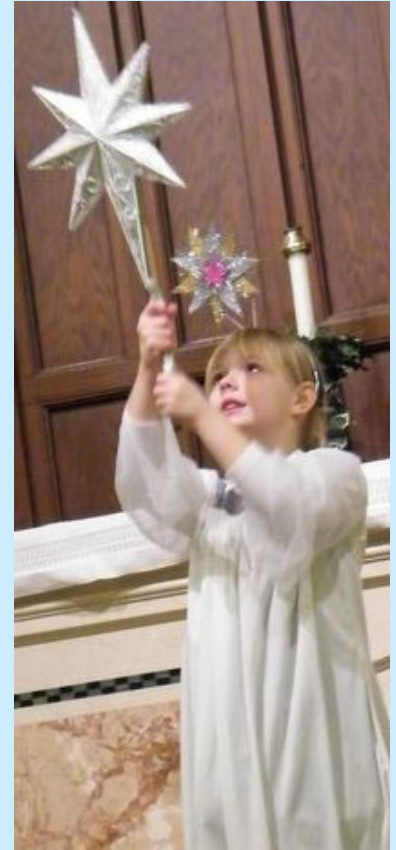


Major Gift Received for Guardian Angel Scholarship


