My name is Joseph Connor (you can call me Joey), and I am the seminarian assigned to St. James for this summer. I am enjoying my stay here, and I am sure the rest of the summer will continue to be as wonderful. I hope to get to know you if I have not already. You can find me at every Mass during the weekend; and, if I am serving that Mass, I will be at the front of the Church afterward to shake hands.

Allow me to tell you about myself; maybe we share something in common. I am the youngest in my family and have an older brother and sister. My home parish is Blessed Sacrament in Alexandria, Virginia where I went for school until fourth grade. I then transferred to St. Mary's School in Old Town, where I completed Junior High School.

I went to Gonzaga College High School in D.C. and played soccer, cross country, and rugby there. Afterward, I studied Electrical Engineering at Virginia Tech and graduated in 2016. St. James Social Outreach Committee Sock and Underwear Drive For Homeless Shelters – June 16 and 23

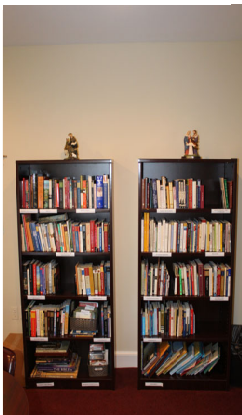
