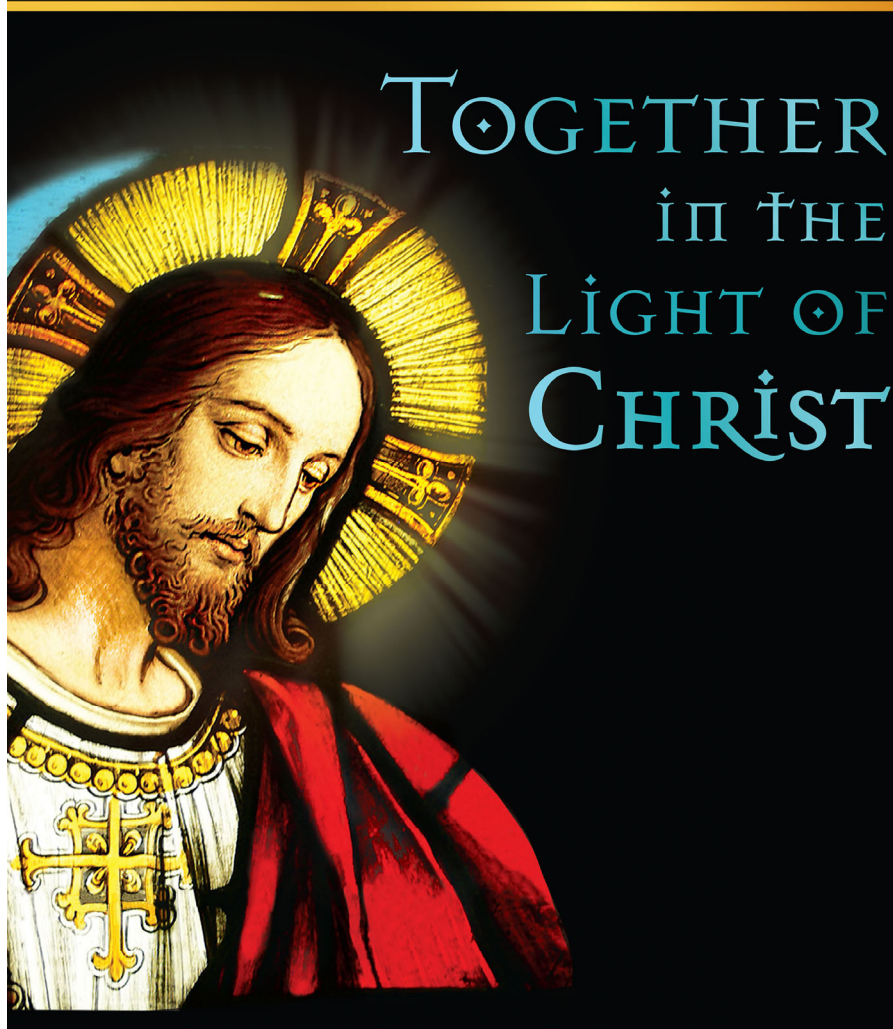

We hope that you will join us for this powerful prayer experience as we journey through Lent in preparation for Easter.

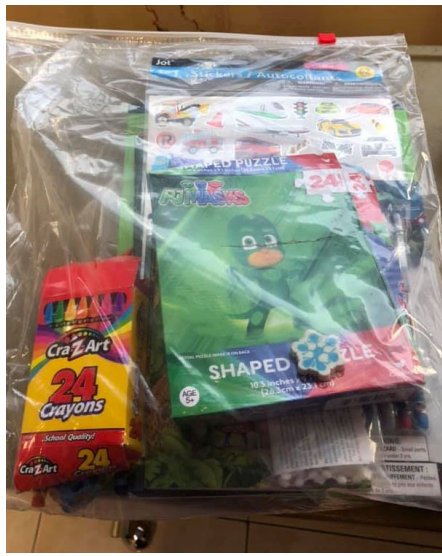
