On The Way

As we begin October, the month of the Holy Rosary, it is fitting that we reflect on the importance of this prayer for our sanctification. When the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to the shepherd children in Fatima, she made this simple request: *Pray the Rosary daily*. The immediate purpose of the request was for the end of the First World War. But the children certainly understood it more broadly — that is, to be a standard practice of the Catholic life. Indeed, apart from the Church's official liturgy, there is no more powerful prayer than the Rosary.

There are two tellings of the Rosary's origin. According to one, the Rosary developed as the people's way of participating in monastic prayer. As monks and nuns recited all 150 Psalms through the course of the week, the people would recite the Hail Mary 150 times. The practice grew and developed into the structured prayer we have now. The other telling is that our Lady gave the Rosary directly to Saint Dominic to assist him in his battle against the Albigensians.

Of course, there is no reason that both accounts cannot be true: that Mary gave to Dominic an already existing prayer to use as his weapon. Indeed, the two stories bring out that the Rosary is *both* a devotion *and* a weapon. By way of it, we grow in affection for Jesus and Mary. We also fight against the evils around us and within us.

The Rosary is powerful precisely because it brings us to greater intimacy with Jesus through Mary. She is always the surest way to go to Him because she is the way He came to us. We go to Him the same way He came to us: through and with Mary. Further, each mystery of the Rosary focuses on an event or mystery of our Lord's life. *He* is the center of the prayer. Mary is the one who helps us to meditate on the mysteries. That focus on His mysteries in union with Mary helps us to receive the grace each one contains.

But did Mary ever say the Rosary? In a sense, yes. In fact, more than anyone else. First, she reflected daily and deeply on the different events of our Lord's life. She was no forgetful hearer (Jas 1:25) but habitually "kept all these things, pondering them in her heart" (Lk 2:19, 51). As His Immaculate Mother, she meditated more often and more perfectly on her Son's life than anyone else can. Further, she would have given more thought and meditation than anyone else to the angel's words: *Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you!* (Lk 1:29) and Elizabeth's greeting: *Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb!* (Lk 1:42)

Caring for Kids Campaign—2019, Collections After All Masses October 5 and 6

Seven Corners Children's Center (SCCC) is a private, non-profit organization started in 1971 by a local group of religious leaders. SCCC partners with Fairfax County to provide day care and family support services to the working poor in a multi-cultural setting.

Every year, 70 at risk children, ages two to five, are given nurturing care and early childhood education that prepares them for kindergarten. In addition they are provided with medical, hearing, dental, speech and vision screenings as needed to ensure that they are ready to learn. Both parents work and pay for these services on a sliding scale.

Through our annual Caring for Kids drive, St. James parishioners have supplemented SCCC funds to help them carry out their mission to these children. Social Outreach Committee members will be collecting after masses the weekend of October 5 and 6. We ask for your generous financial response to help them meet this year's needs.

More than **150 people** help monthly with Food Distribution. The **car raffle raised \$14,000** for our parish. 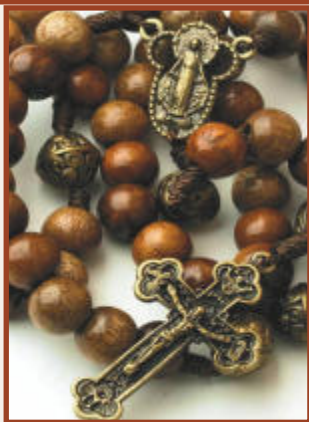
